### SUBJECT:

Proposed Fee Adjustments to the Planning & Development Fee Schedule.

### REQUEST(S):

That your Board take the following actions relative to the portion of the RMA Planning & Development Fee Schedule pertaining to Project Review, Employee Housing and Long Range Planning:

1. Conduct the public hearing considering the proposed fees as listed in Attachment "A", 2006/2007 Summary of Proposed Fees.
2. At the conclusion of the public hearing, approve by resolution the fee adjustments based upon the recovery rates desired by your Board, and direct staff to amend the Planning & Development Fee Schedule to reflect such changes.
3. Direct that said fee adjustments take effect August 5, 2006 and be incorporated into the revenue estimates for the proposed FY 2006/2007 Budget.

### SUMMARY:

Health and Safety Code Section 17951 and Government Code Sections 65909.5, 66014 and 66451.2 provide statutory authority for establishment of fees proposed herein, subject to requirements that such fees shall not exceed the estimated reasonable cost of providing services for which the fee is charged. The current and proposed fees are based on cost recovery estimates for direct labor and indirect cost for overhead and administration.

### Project Review

Fee adjustments for the Project Review portion are proposed for lot line adjustments, site plans, subdivision maps, special use permits, zone changes and variances. Specifically proposed is the elimination of additional fees for more than two lots for lot line adjustments and elimination of the fee currently required

for waiver of information required on site plans. A reduction of the fees for preliminary subdivision maps and setback variances is also proposed. New fees for special use permit site inspections, extensions for final site plan reviews, minor modifications of site plans, zone change text amendments and zone change verification letters are requested. The hourly rate of \$95 for special use permits and site plan reviews is requested to increase to \$100. The hourly rate of \$100 is also requested to replace the existing fees for zone changes to more effectively match the fee of the zone change with the cost.

In April of 2004 your Board authorized a 10% increase in recovery rates for subdivision maps; a 6% decrease in recovery rates for parcel maps; a 36% decrease in recovery rates for zone variances; and a rate of \$95/hour for special use permits and site plan reviews in the Project Review portion of the Planning & Development Fee Schedule effective July, 1, 2004. Project Review's revenue showed a 30% increase after the fee changes were implemented and yielded a cost recovery rate of 97% as compared to 57% in 03/04FY. The cost recovery rate for the current year is estimated at 82% if one-time costs for document imaging are not included in the division's total expenses. Project Review's revenue is not anticipated to increase significantly as a result of the requested fee adjustments, if approved.

#### Employee Housing

The Employee Housing Program currently has 150 active facilities housing 1,736 agricultural workers. The proposed fee increases would raise the current \$15 fee for employee to be housed to \$20; the current \$100 fee for the Permit to Operate to \$200; and the \$60 reinspection fee to an hourly rate of \$100 with a minimum one-hour charge. Employee Housing's revenue is anticipated to increase by approximately \$24,000 and the cost recovery rate should be at 100% if the requested fees are approved.

In April of 2004 your Board authorized a 25% increase in the fee for each employee the operator of the Facility intends to house, effective July 1, 2004. Employee Housing's revenue increased 8% in 04/05 with a cost recovery rate of 71%. The cost recovery rate is estimated to decrease to 69% this fiscal year.

#### Long Range Planning

Fee adjustments for the Long Range Planning portion are proposed for agricultural preserves and environmental reviews. Specifically proposed are an increase in the fees for notice of non-renewal of agricultural preserves and an increase in the hourly rate to \$100 for General Plan Amendments, agricultural preserve cancellations, surface mining permits and environmental reviews.

In April of 2004 your Board authorized a rate of \$95/hour for environmental reviews in the Long Range Planning portion of the Planning & Development Fee Schedule effective July 1, 2004. Long Range Planning's revenue increased 49% and yielded a cost recovery rate of 25% in 04/05FY. The cost recovery rate for 05/06FY adjusted for one-time expenses and revenues, remains at 25%. Long Range Planning's revenue is anticipated to increase by approximately \$10,000 if the requested fee adjustments are approved. This increase in revenue should result in a cost recovery rate of 27%.

#### **FINANCING:**

The proposed fee adjustments for the Planning & Development Fee Schedule are based on time/cost analysis for the review and processing of these matters. Labor costs and an overhead rate comprised of indirect costs that are applied as a percentage of the direct cost make up the fees.

The indirect cost items encompass various components including, but not limited to, management and administration, clerical, office supplies and equipment, County services and costs, and County Counsel support.

2. Denial of proposed fee adjustments.

The Auditor/Treasurer's Office has been sent a copy of this Agenda Item.

If fee adjustments are approved for any of the portions, the necessary changes to the Planning & Development Fee Schedule will be made. Further, coordination with County Assessor/Clerk-Recorder, Health & Human Services and County Fire will also be necessary to account for any increases in their fee portions associated with the processing of all planning and building permits that may ultimately be approved by your Board. It is assumed that any fee adjustments will be effective August 5, 2006 unless otherwise directed by action of your Board with respect to any portion of said Planning & Development Fees. The amended Fee Schedule will be available by that date. The IT Department will need to make the programming changes in Permits Plus to reflect the changes in fees.
