<u>Subject</u>: Amendment No. 4 to Agreement No. 19875 between the County of Tulare and the Tule River Indian Tribal Council.

#### Request:

- 1) Request your Board approve and ratify Amendment No. 4 to Agreement 19875 between the County of Tulare and the Tule River Indian Tribal Council for the period of July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2008.
- 2) Authorize the Chairman to sign the Amendment to Agreement 19875.

<u>Summary</u>: The Tule River Indian Tribal Council is seeking to extend its agreement with the Sheriff's Department for exclusive law enforcement services on reservation lands. In the past, the Tribal Council has funded for one (1) full-time Deputy Sheriff II position including salary, benefits, training, use of equipment, use of a vehicle, and supervisory costs for a Sergeant (10%) and Lieutenant (5%). It is now the desire of the Tribal Council to increase to two (2) additional Deputy Sheriff II positions for a total of three (3) Full-Time Equivalent Deputy Sheriff II positions.

**Financing:** The Tule River Indian Council agrees to pay Tulare County for the costs of three (3) Deputy Sheriff's including salary, benefits, training, use of equipment, purchase of 2 additional patrol vehicles (\$68,000 to be paid upfront), and administrative overhead for supervisory costs for a Sergeant (10%) and Lieutenant (5%). The total amount for this two-year agreement is \$707,996. There will be no negative impact upon the General Fund. Monies have been budgeted in FY 06/07 for the amendment to this agreement; therefore, a budget adjustment is not necessary.

<u>Alternatives</u>: Deny Agreement although there is no net cost to the County.
