SUBJECT: Report to the State of California Department of Transportation on the Revision of Mileage of Maintained County Roads.

REQUEST(S):
That the Board of Supervisors:
Adopt the Revision of Mileage of Maintained County Roads.

SUMMARY:
Total mileage of maintained County roads is reported by the State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) to the State Controller on a monthly basis reflecting changes for State actions such as relinquishment of State Highways to the County. The Streets and Highways Code provides for the County to make annual updates for such things as adding new roads resulting from subdivisions and removing roads as a result of city annexations and abandonment's. The total mileage of maintained County roads last certified by the State on August 31, 2006, was 3047.80 miles. Seventy-two hundredths (0.72) of a mile of road has been added to Tulare County's Maintained Road System by roads in new subdivisions. Thirty six and ninety-seven hundredths (36.97) miles of road have been deleted from Tulare County's Maintained Road System as a result of annexations and three and five tenths (3.50) miles as a result of maintenance agreements. This results in a net reduction of 39.75 miles of maintained County roads. Therefore, the revised total mileage of maintained County roads as of December 31, 2006, is 3008.05.

SUBJECT: Revision to Mileage of Maintained County Roads

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

For Fiscal Year 2005/2006, Tulare County received approximately \$2,555.73 from the Motor Vehicle Fuel and License Tax for each mile of County maintained road. These funds are apportioned based on a variety of factors. The deletion of 39.75 miles of maintained County roads is expected to have minimal effect on the revenue to Tulare County. Costs for the maintenance and operation of the road system, as well as County liability as a result of this minimal decrease, will not be significant.

The transportation infrastructure in the areas of annexations and areas covered by Maintenance Agreement will be maintained by cities. Roads in new subdivisions will be maintained by the County of Tulare.

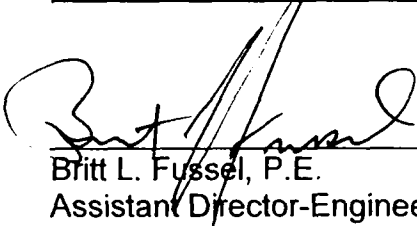

the following resolution was made, passed and adopted.

WHEREAS, Section 2121 of the Streets and Highways Code provides that each year, the County shall submit to the State of California Department of Transportation any additions to or exclusions from its mileage of maintained County roads, specifying the termini and mileage of each route added or excluded; and

WHEREAS, on March 21, 2006, the Tulare County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution Number 2006-0171 reporting the Revision of Mileage of Maintained County Roads to be a total of 3,047.80 miles as of December 31, 2005.

THEREFORE, it is resolved that the County now finds that the total mileage of maintained roads is 3,008.05 miles as of December 31, 2006, and that the mileage of maintained County roads be revised in accordance with the indication on the maps marked Exhibit "A" and in accordance with the addition or correction on the tabulations marked Exhibit "B", both being on file in the office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, copies of which are being sent to the State of California Department of Transportation.

The foregoing resolution was duly and regularly adopted at a meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Tulare, State of California on the 1st day of May 2007.

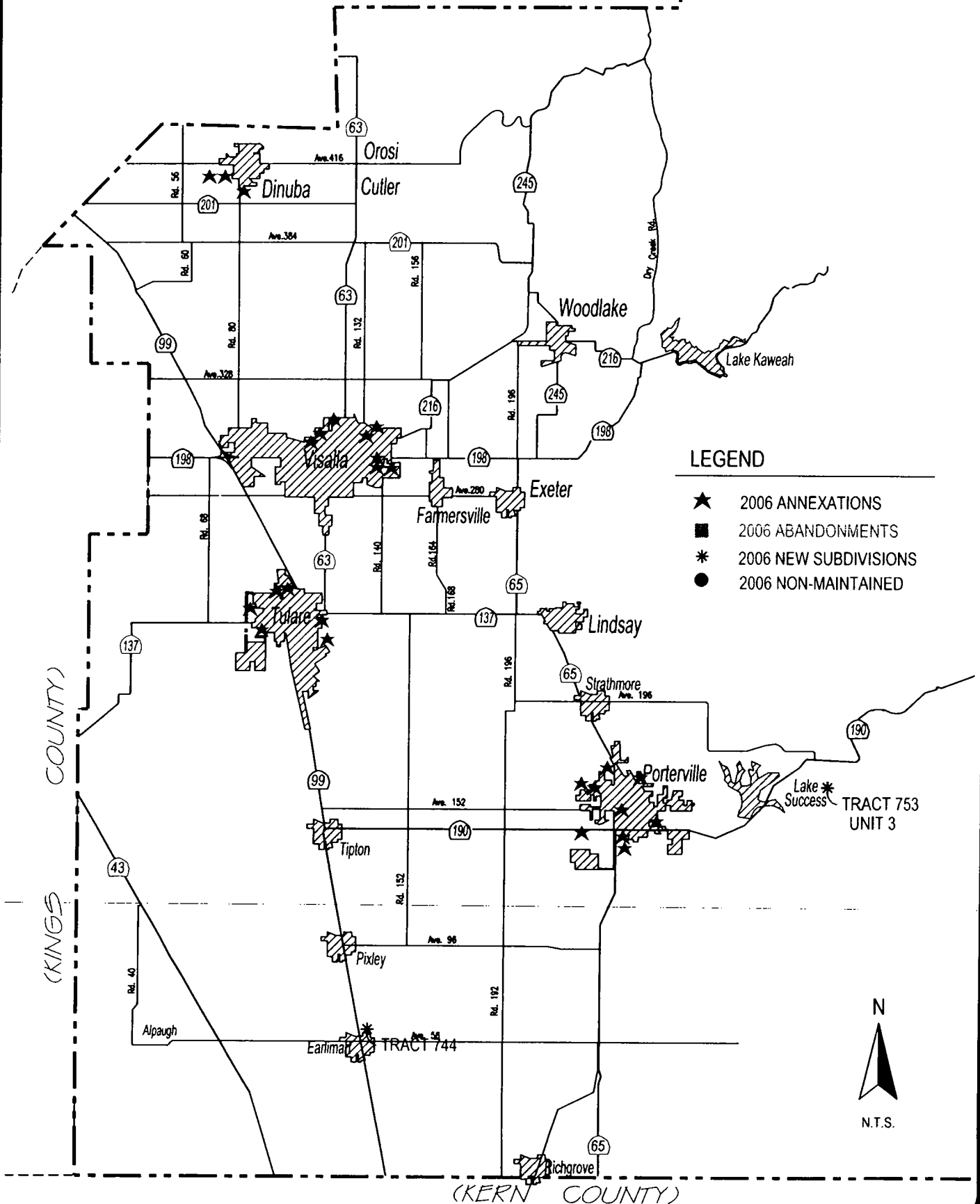

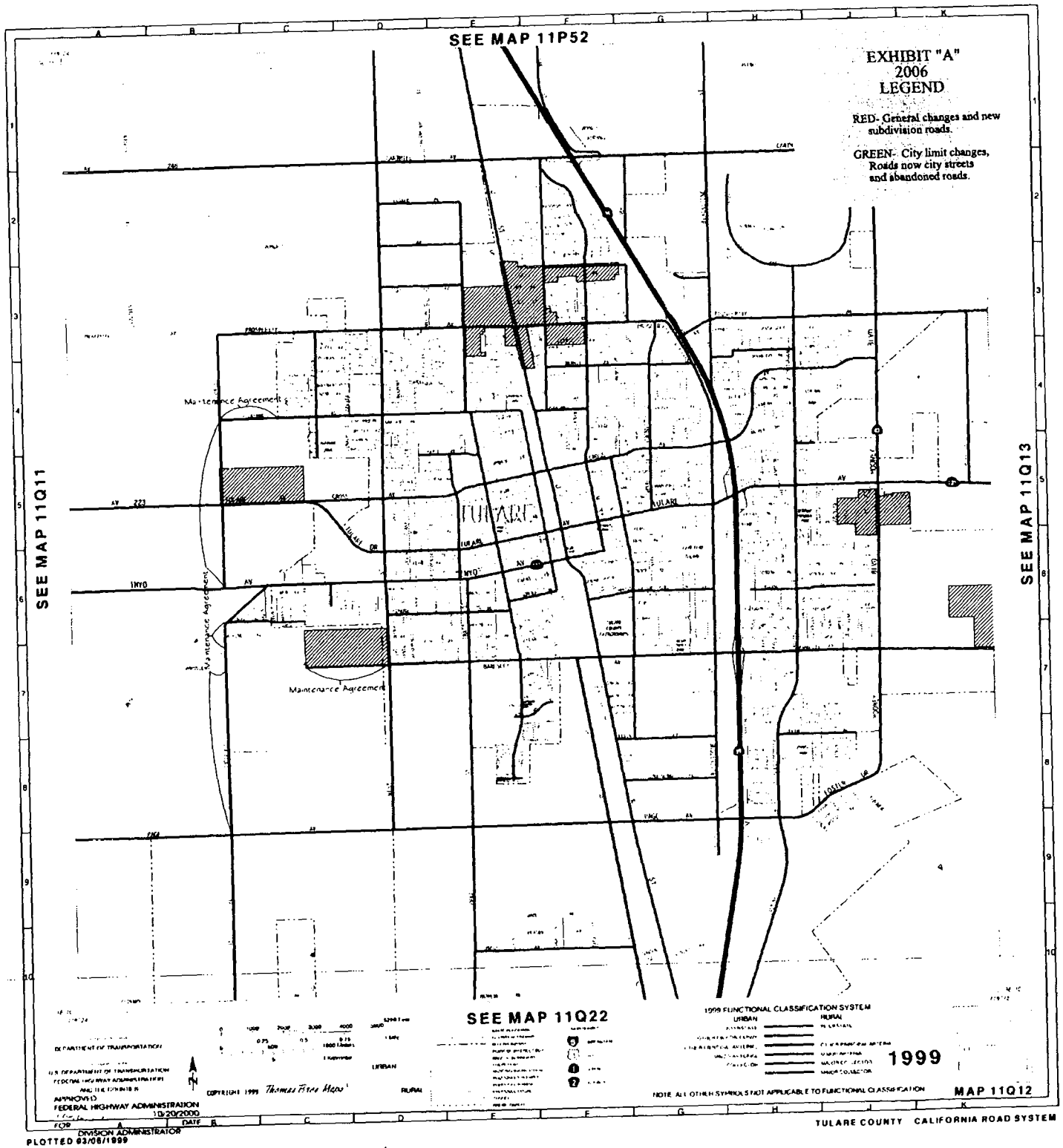

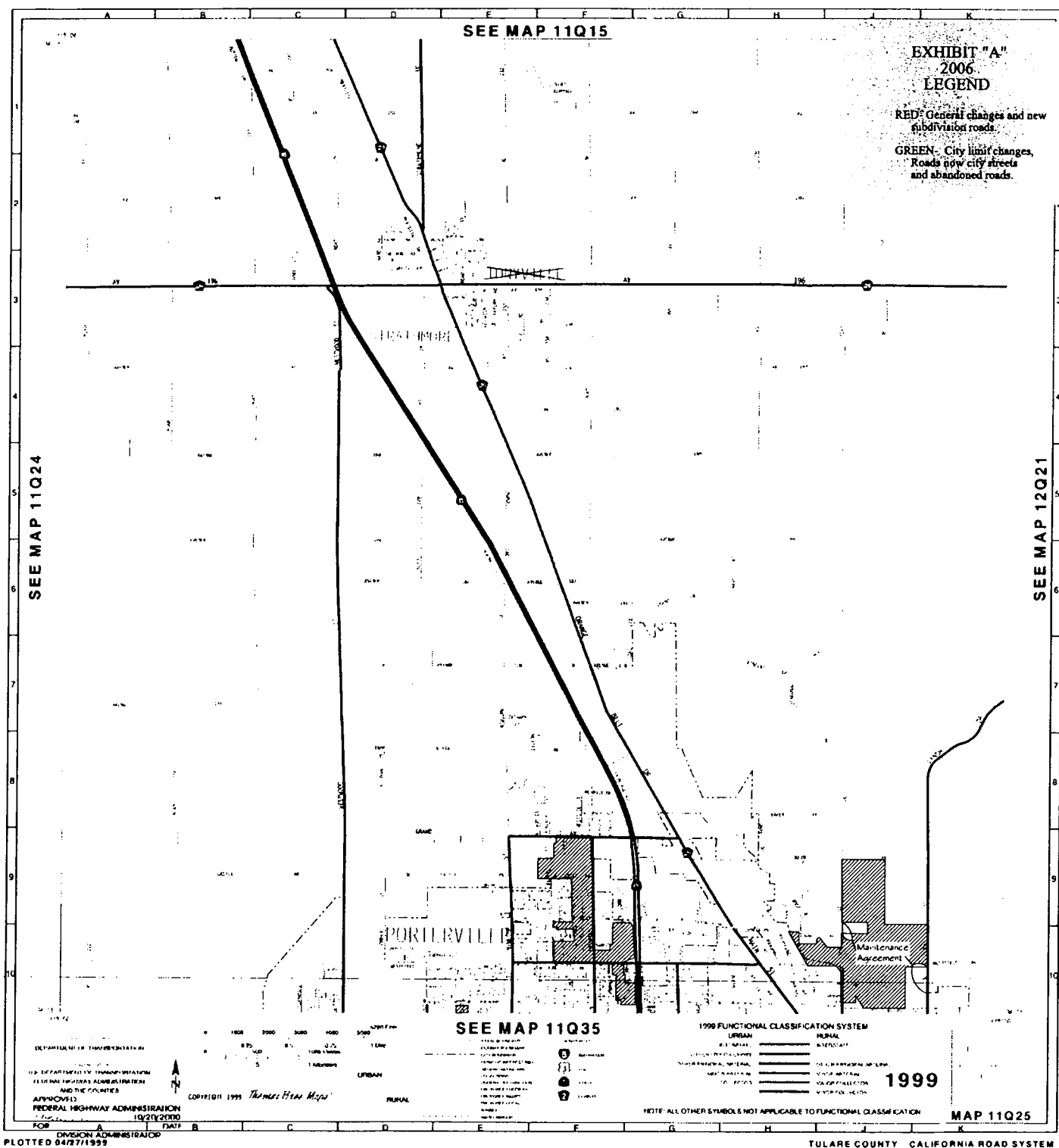

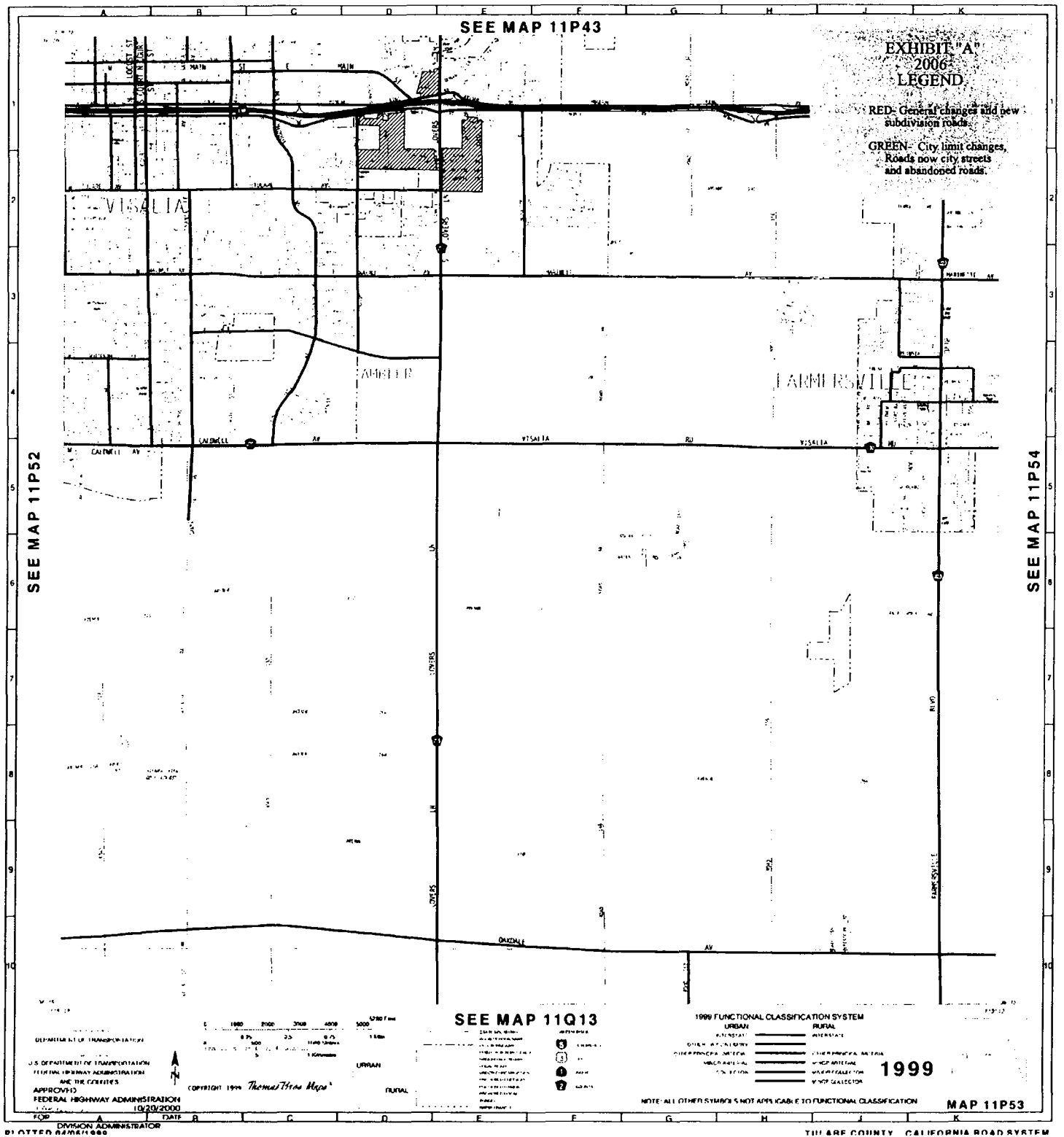
