SUBJECT:

Donation of used fire protection equipment

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Authorize and approve the Chairman of the Board to sign an Agreement to authorize the Fire Chief to donate used fire protection equipment as specified in Exhibit "A" of the Agreement to the California Fire Chiefs' Association, Bomberos Section.

SUMMARY:

The Fire Department replaces fire protection equipment that is identified as wornout or unserviceable. This equipment is typically ripped, torn, broken, or worn out beyond acceptable standards for use in California. Rather than take this equipment to the dump, the Department is requesting authorization to donate it to an organization which would clean and repair it, and redistribute it to fire departments in Mexico. County Counsel has approved an Agreement to allow the donation by the County to the California Fire Chiefs' Association, Bomberos Section, as provided in Government Code Section 25504.
