SUBJECT: Donation of surplus fire engine to R-Ranch in the Sequoias.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Authorize and approve the Chairman of the Board to sign an Agreement to authorize the Fire Chief to donate a surplus Tulare County Fire engine specified in Exhibit "A" of the Agreement to R-Ranch in the Sequoias.

SUMMARY:

Tulare County Fire Department periodically purchases new fire engines to insure that they have dependable equipment to protect the citizens of Tulare County. As new fire engines come on line, older engines are either retired or placed into reserve status. The Owners' Association of R-Ranch in the Sequoias has asked to receive a retired fire engine to be used by their Volunteer Fire Brigade. Tulare County Fire Department has identified an obsolete 1976 Ford Fire Engine which is no longer suitable for County service. The engine is still a usable piece of equipment which will work well in a department that does not respond to emergencies every day. The Department is requesting authorization to donate this fire engine to R-Ranch in the Sequoias. County Counsel has approved an Agreement to allow the donation as provided in Government Code Section 25504.
