### SUBJECT:

Accept the Richgrove Stormwater Drainage, Air Quality Improvement and Recreation Project – Phase 2 as complete and authorize filing of a Notice of Completion.

### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Directors:

- 1. Accept the Richgrove Stormwater Drainage, Air Quality Improvement and Recreation Project Phase 2 as constructed by Bill Nelson General Engineering Construction, Inc. as complete; and
- 2. Authorize the Tulare County Redevelopment Agency Executive Director to sign and record a Notice of Completion for the Project.

### **SUMMARY:**

On November 14, 2006 the Tulare County Redevelopment Agency (TCRA) entered into a contract with Bill Nelson General Engineering Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$1,111,798 for the construction of the Richgrove Stormwater Drainage, Air Quality Improvement and Recreation Project – Phase 2. Funding for the project was provided by the United States Department of Agriculture – Rural Development (USDA-RD) and the Richgrove Redevelopment Project Area.

This portion of the project involved the construction and/or installation of stormwater drainage appurtenances such as drainage inlets, catch basins, cross gutters,

pipelines and discharge facilities.

A contract is currently in place for Community Services and Employment Training, Inc. (CSET) to perform the finishing work for Phase 2 of this project. These tasks include the installation of a solid materials removal device, security fencing, landscaping, irrigation system, baseball/softball backstop and 2 hybrid football/soccer goals on the site of the recently constructed 3.9 acre dual-purpose stormwater basin/recreation park.

As certified by the Tulare County Resource Management Agency (RMA) – Roads/Operations Division, this project is now complete. TCRA staff herein requests approval to file a Notice of Completion with the office of the County Assessor/Clerk Recorder.

### FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

Construction of Phase 2 of this project was funded through a \$1,627,000 Rural Utilities Service loan provided by USDA-RD. Future tax increment generated by the Richgrove Redevelopment Project Area has been pledged toward debt service for a period not to exceed 25 years from the date of the loan closing. All operations, maintenance and emergency response costs will be funded by a community-wide assessment district that was established by a successful Proposition 218 election on February 25, 2004. No General Fund cost or impact.

### LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

- 1) Safety and Security the stormwater drainage improvements will provide adequate facilities for protection of the public.
- 2) Quality of Life the dual-purpose stormwater/recreation park will provide greater recreational and cultural opportunities.

### **ALTERNATIVES:**

None recommended

### **INVOLVEMENT OF OTHER DEPARTMENTS OR AGENCIES:**

USDA-RD, RMA, County Counsel, Risk Management, Richgrove Elementary School District (RESD) and the Richgrove Community Services District (RCSD). Under the terms of a Joint Powers Agreement, the RESD and RCSD will jointly own, operate and maintain the stormwater drainage basin and its improvements upon completion of the entire project.
