**SUBJECT:** 2007/2008 Transit Agreement with the City of Tulare to provide service to County residents in the Tulare Service Area.

**REQUEST(S):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Ratify and approve 2007/2008 Transit Agreement with the City of Tulare, for providing transit service, retroactive to July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.
2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed agreement as of July 1, 2007, and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date.

**SUMMARY:**

The Agreement provides for the coordination of transit services for citizens of local unincorporated areas in the Tulare Service Area. These County residents can be best served by the City of Tulare's service. As a result, the County has agreed to reimburse the City of Tulare for extending service to include unincorporated areas adjacent to the City and provide public transit to County residents in those areas.

In fiscal year 2007/2008, an estimated 2% of fixed route trips served County residents in these unincorporated areas. This represents approximately 6,000 riders.

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The County share of the City of Tulare cost for this service in fiscal year 2007/2008 has been calculated to be \$15,435.

In 2006/2007, the County's contribution for this service was \$24,488. This year's decreased contribution is due to the re-evaluation of County ridership percentages between the City of Tulare and the County of Tulare. Execution of this Agreement was delayed beyond July 1, 2007, because of ongoing negotiations between the City of Tulare and the County of Tulare.

**FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

The County's total share of costs under this Agreement will be \$15,435. This amount will be paid from the County's Local Transportation Fund (LTF). This Agreement allows Tulare County Association of Governments (TCAG) to redistribute a portion of the County's LTF to the City of Tulare for this service. There are no net County costs.

**LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

This coordinated transit system provides quality service to County residents in the Tulare Area. The Strategic Business Plan Initiatives, under the Safety and Security section, calls for improvement and maintenance of transportation infrastructure; this service addresses that initiative.

**ALTERNATIVES:**

1. The County could provide transit service to its residents through a separate agreement with another transit provider. This would create a duplication of services and routes, as well as an increase in capital expenditures.
2. The County could eliminate the transit service provided by this agreement. This would leave many County residents with no access to affordable transportation.




