specialty position of Primary Care Practitioner ${\bf T}$.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve the job specification and reclassification of position #0707, Primary Care Practitioner, to a specialty position of Primary Care Practitioner T.
- 2. Approve the Personnel Resolution and amended compensation for the Primary Care Practitioner **T** classification to \$184,208.00 annually.
- 3. Approve the Side Letter of Agreement between the County of Tulare and the Professional Association of Tulare County Physicians (PATCOP).

SUMMARY:

This current allocated position #0707 Primary Care Practitioner is located at the Hillman Health Clinic in Tulare, CA. It has been determined by the Health & Human Services Agency that this position would be better utilized if the Board would reclass it as a specialty position titled Primary Care Practitioner T and allow the incumbent to focus on the high number of chronically ill patients at the clinic. This will enable optimal care throughout the week at the Hillman Health Clinic with a primary focus on high our risk patients. Reclassifying this position will allow the focus needed to accomplish maximum attention to the greatest necessities at the clinic. Meet and Confer has been completed.

PRIMARY CARE PRACTITIONER-T

[Non-Competitive (At-will)] County of Tulare

DEFINITION

To examine, diagnose and treat patients referred to the Tulare County public health care clinics.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED AND EXERCISED

General direction is provided by the Health Services Director, or his/her designee.

Responsibilities may include direct and indirect supervision of mid-level providers. Provide medical direction for mid-level practitioners, nursing and other clinical staff.

DUTIES may include, but are not necessarily limited to:

Provide medical services in clinics in the field of Family Practice, Internal Medicine or Pediatrics.

Will be available to examine and manage patient care five days per week.

Examine, diagnose, prescribe and administer treatment to patients.

Jointly manage the general clinic appointment schedule with the nursing supervisor.

Determine necessity for referral and refer persons requiring special diagnostic procedures or treatments to appropriate sources.

Carry a disproportionately high level of clinically ill patients at risk of hospitalization.

Admit patients to area hospitals as necessary and in coordination with other physicians.

Act as supervising physician for one or two mid-level practitioners.

Maintain clinic records and prepare reports.

May act as consultant to the health care system.

Participate on committees of the medical staff such as Quality Assurance or Pharmacy and therapeutics as assigned by Assistant Director-Medical.

Perform related duties as assigned. (Essential duties may vary from position to position within this classification. Reasonable accommodation will be made when requested and determined by the County to be appropriate under applicable law.)

NECESSARY EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

Knowledge of:

Principles and practices of current medicine including preventive medicine.

Skill/Ability to:

Perform medical diagnosis and treatment.

Analyze situations accurately and adopt an effective course of action.

Speak and write effectively.

Establish and maintain effective relationships with public, staff and private medical sector.

Education and Experience:

Any combination of education and experience that could likely provide the required knowledge, skills, and abilities is qualifying. A typical way to obtain the knowledge, skills, and abilities would be:

Education:

Graduation from a medical school approved by the Board of Medical Quality Assurance.

Experience:

One year experience as an intern at a hospital approved by the Board of Medical Quality Assurance; completion of a residency in Pediatrics, Internal Medicine or Family Practice from a program approved by the American Board of Medical Specialties.

LICENSE OR CERTIFICATE

Possession of a valid Physician's and Surgeon's license issued by the State of California; Board eligible or certified in Family Practice, Internal Medicine or Pediatrics. Possession of, or ability to obtain an appropriate, valid California driver's license. Obtain a supervising physician certificate from the California Medical Board within the frame required by the Director of Health Services.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Possession of admitting privileges at a local hospital or hospitals as determined by the Health Services Director. Applicants may be appointed with immediate application of hospital admitting privileges; continued employment is contingent upon obtaining the specified privileges.

Side Letter of Agreement Between the Professional Association Tulare County Physicians (PATCOP) and the County of Tulare

The parties agree to reclassify one Primary Care Practitioner position to a single position classification of Primary Care Practitioner "T".

In addition to the regular duties of a Primary Care Practitioner, the Primary Care Practitioner "T", shall carry a disproportionately high level of clinically ill patients at risk of hospitalization. The position shall be available to examine and manage patients five days per week to optimize care for high-risk patients; and also be jointly responsible for general clinic appointment schedules along with the nursing supervisor. General direction shall come from the Director of Health Services, or his/her designee.

Due to the increased level of responsibilities, the parties agree to establish the rate of compensation at \$184,208.00 annually.

This agreement is subject to ratification by the Board of Supervisors. It is proposed that this agreement will be effective as soon as administratively possible upon ratification.
