SUBJECT: Approve a fixed-asset purchase for a Digital In-Car Police Video System

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve a fixed-asset purchase of a Digital In-Car Police Video System.
2. Authorize the necessary budget adjustments per the attached AUD 308 (4/5ths vote required).

SUMMARY:

The Sheriff's Department is requesting to purchase a car-mounted, digital video surveillance system. This system includes three cameras for surveillance around the vehicle, as well as the back seat. The system's computerized controls are mounted in the dashboard, where the officer can also monitor video footage from the cameras.

This equipment will be used to gather and report intelligence data relating to the illicit possession and distribution of marijuana and to investigate and report instances involving the trafficking of other controlled substances located within Tulare County.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The cost for the Digital In-Car Police Video System equipment and installation is \$5,495. The funding for this system will come from the High Intensity Drug
