HONORING ELLEN GORELICK FOR HER LONGSTANDING EFFORTS TO PRESERVE TULARE COUNTY HISTORY

WHEREAS, Ellen Gorelick has labored tirelessly to help document and preserve Tulare County history, working at the Tulare Historical Museum for more than 25 years; and

WHEREAS, Ellen and her husband, the Honorable Judge Walter Gorelick, are charter members of the Tulare City Historical Society; and

WHEREAS, prior to her position as curator, from 1984 to 1987, Ellen Gorelick was a member of the museum's planning and building committee. Ellen was also the Tulare Chamber of Commerce Woman of the Year in 2003; and

WHEREAS, Ellen is such a fixture at the Tulare Historical Museum, some regulars call it "Ellen's Place"; and

WHEREAS, Ellen curated close to 100 exhibits, and helped create permanent collections dedicated to Sim Iness, Bob Mathias, Admiral Elmo R. Zumwalt, Jr., and the Manuel Toledo Military Collection, which shows her dedication to preserving the history of Tulare County; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Tulare hereby honors and pays tribute to Tulare historian Ellen Gorelick for all of her hard work and dedication to the City of Tulare and Tulare County.
