Amendment to agreement between Tulare County and Victim

Compensation and Government Claims Board.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Ratify and approve amendment to Agreement number 23151 between Tulare County and the Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board to clarify the language in Exhibit A of the agreement regarding staff time and invoicing retroactive to July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2009.
- 2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed agreement as of July 1, 2007 and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date.
- 3. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the amendment to agreement.

SUMMARY:

The agreement between the Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board and Tulare County was established July 1, 2007 and remains in effect until June 30, 2009. The agreement allows the operation of a restitution and recovery program in the amount of \$152,442. The agreement established a position that tracks restitution orders and ensures restitution is ordered on appropriate criminal cases.

The Victims Compensation and Government Claims Board amended the agreement in order to clarify the current language in exhibit A of the agreement regarding staff time and invoicing.
