SUBJECT:

Approve Agreements for a Community Improvement Program Project for Public Improvement Projects in Cutler-Orosi

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Directors:

- 1. Approve an Agreement for Phase I of a Community Improvement Program Project with Community Services & Employment Training Inc. for installation of 1,970 linear feet of curb, gutter and sidewalk along Road 126 from Avenue 419 to Avenue 422 in the amount of \$262,002.78.
- 2. Approve an Agreement for Phase 2 of a Community Improvement Program Project with Community Services & Employment Training Inc. for installation of 1,250 linear feet of curb and gutter and 800 linear feet of sidewalk along Avenue 419 from Road 126 to State Route 63 in the amount of \$158,190.36.
- 3. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the Agreements.

SUMMARY:

On May 20, 2003 the Board of Supervisors authorized the submittal of a Safe Routes to School grant application for the Cutler-Orosi Joint Unified School District. The grant was approved for \$435,000 with a local match of 12% (\$31,440.33 for Phase I) and (\$18,982.84 for Phase 2) of grant funding to be paid by the Cutler-Orosi Joint Unified School District. Grant funds will be used to construct sidewalk improvements along Road 126.

The attached agreements are to provide for labor and equipment, to construct curb, gutter and sidewalk along Road 126 from Avenue 419 to Avenue 422 (Phase 1) and along Avenue 419 from Road 126 to State Route 63 (Phase 2). Work will commence once authorized by Caltrans. The Tulare County Redevelopment Agency

(TCRA) shall provide for purchase of all construction and materials to complete the project.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The Safe Routes to School grant is for \$435,000, requiring a local match of 12% of grant funding which will be paid by the Cutler-Orosi Joint Unified School District. TCRA staff time will be paid from the Cutler-Orosi budget contained in accounting line RO3-RO3-2300.

Phase I is for \$262,002.78 with a 12% match (\$31,440.33) and Phase 2 is for \$158,190.36 with a 12% match (\$18,982.84).

There will be no direct cost to the County's General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

Quality of Life – The proposed Safe Routes to Schools Program is designed to provide a safe place for school children to walk to and from school, improve air quality and increase the health of children within the community.

<u>Safety Well Being</u> — The proposed Safe Routes to Schools Program promotes walking and biking to school through education and incentives. The program also addresses the safety concerns of parents by encouraging greater enforcement of traffic laws, educating the public, and exploring ways to create safer streets.

County Counsel to review all documents; Auditor/Controller for accounting and funds disbursement; the Resource Management Agency Community and Development Services-Community Development and Redevelopment Division to provide project management; RMA Graphics and Engineering to provided design and engineering of sidewalks, curbs, and gutter; Community Services and Employment Training, Inc. to provide construction labor; Cutler-Orosi Unified School District to provide a local match; and Caltrans to provide general support.
