WHEREAS, Frances Cutler, and her husband Frank, became involved with Catholic Social Services since it first started in October 1968. Frances was very involved with Catholic Daughters, raising funds for charity; and


WHEREAS, Frances and Frank were instrumental in the development of the Good News Center, where Sister Ursula's Kitchen is located. They helped fulfill Sister Ursula's dream of having a site where homeless people and the poor could come for a hot meal. More than 500,000 meals have been served since at Sister Ursula's Kitchen; and

WHEREAS, when Frank died in 1985, Frances remained on the Board of Directors of Catholic Social Services. Frances went on to teach, work carnivals at George McCann School and was a Eucharistic Minister for 18 years at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Visalia; and

WHEREAS, Frances continues her commitment to the church and to the Good News Center. She is dedicated to making sure that Sister Ursula's Kitchen continues to operate and serve the homeless and the poor.



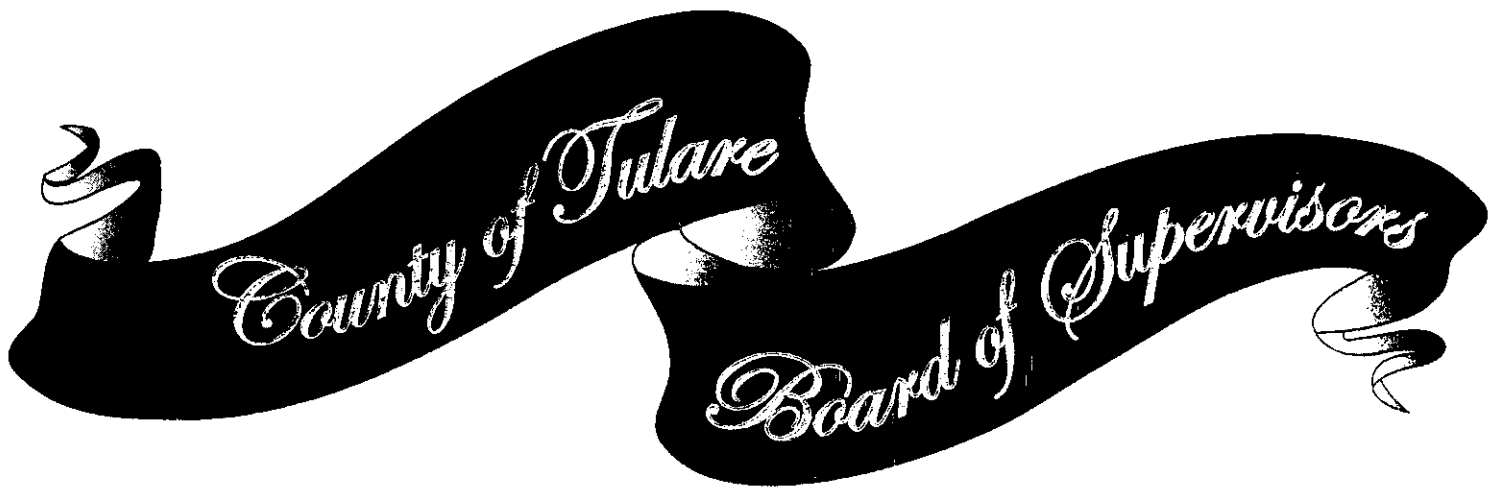
