


Map of Proposed Vacation of Lilac Lane in Wilsonia

PETITION FOR VACATION OF COUNTY ROAD

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF TULARE

The undersigned persons hereby petition the Board of Supervisors of the County of Tulare to vacate the County road or portion thereof, which is described as follows:

That portion of Lilac Lane that is undeveloped and extends east of Grant Lane in the Mesa Addition to Wilsonia that adjoins Lots 1 thru 5 of Mesa Addition to Wilsonia, in the County of Tulare, State of California, as per map recorded in Book 17, Page 2 of Maps, Tulare County Records.

Said petitioners request the Board of Supervisors to vacate the County road, or portion thereof, which is described above, for the following reasons:

The undeveloped portion of Lilac Lane to the east of Grant Lane is grown over with brush and is a fire hazard to the structure on lots 5 and 4 and is of the type of flammable material that is recommended to be cleared as a fuel break for a distance of 30 feet from structures. This undeveloped portion of Lilac Lane has not been maintained for fire protection by the County of Tulare.

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In accordance with Resolution No. 93-0484 the petitioners herewith deposit with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors the required fee of \$506.00. The petitioners understand and agree that the \$506.00 fee deposited with the Clerk shall cover the cost of preparing, publishing, and posting notices of hearing, and the costs of investigation by the Resource Management Agency and other interested County officers and employees, and that no portion thereof shall be refunded.

TULARE COUNTY RESOURCE MANAGEMENT AGENCY STAFF REPORT GENERAL PLAN REFERRAL, GPR NO. 08-004 (DISPOSITION OF PRPOPERTY)

PROPOSAL:

Request to vacate a portion of Lilac Lane west of Hazel Lane, north of Grant Lane, and in east central Wilsonia.

LOCATION:

The portion of Lilac Lane that is proposed to be vacated is located west of Hazel Lane, north of Grant Lane, and in east central Wilsonia described as Section 5, Township 14 South, Range 28 East of the Mount Diablo Base & Meridian.

FACTS AND FINDINGS:

- 1. <u>General Plan Elements</u>: 1964 General Plan and Environmental Resources Management Element.
 - a. Land Use: N/A County right of way
 - b. Circulation: Local Rural Road
 - c. Open Space: National and State Lands
 - d. Urban Boundaries: The portion of Lilac Lane that is proposed to be vacated is not within any urban boundary.

2. Zoning and Physical Use of the Land:

Site: County right of way

North: Zoned A-1 (Agriculture)

South: Zoned A-1 (Agriculture)-residences

East: Zoned A-1 (Agriculture)

West: Zoned A-1 (Agriculture)-residences

3. Flooding:

According to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP), Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) for Community No. 065066 dated September 29, 1986; Panel No. 0050B, the portion of Lilac Lane that is proposed to be vacated is located within Flood Zone X areas with no flooding; based on elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.

4. <u>Agricultural Preserves</u>:

N/A

5. Access:

The portion of Lilac Lane that is proposed to be vacated will be incorporated into the adjacent lots. Approval of this proposal does not eliminate public access to any parcels of record.

6. Public Utilities:

All rights-of-way and easements of record for public utilities are reserved and accepted pursuant to Section 8340 of the Streets and Highways Code.

CEQA REQUIREMENTS:

The Engineering Division of the Tulare County Resource Management, as the lead agency, will prepare the environmental documents under the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Planning and Development Director find this GPR 08-004 is not in conflict with the Tulare County General Plan as the Environmental Resources Management Element allows open space within National and State Land areas.

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
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
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
