REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Sign and send a letter of support for the Alder Creek Fire Safe Council's application to receive \$330,000 to develop an Environmental Impact Statement to help prepare a fire break to the West of Sequoia Crest.

SUMMARY:

The Alder Creek Fire Safe Council, in the community of Sequoia Crest, is applying for a \$330,000 grant from the Sierra Nevada Conservancy. The grant will provide funds for the Fire Safe Council to prepare an Environmental Impact Statement for a fire break to the West of Sequoia Crest.

The Fire Safe Council is working with the United States Forest Service (USFS) because the fire break is on USFS land. The fire break will provide an increased level of protection from catastrophic wildfires in the Sequoia Crest area. The requested \$330,000 will provide the funding to conduct the necessary environmental reviews to plan shaded-canopy fuel breaks.

The Tulare County Board of Supervisors has consistently supported forest
