SUBJECT:

Joint Board of Supervisors and Tulare County Planning Commission Workshop on Due Process, Entanglement, Bias and Conflict of Interest in Land Use Matters Presented by County Counsel

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Hold a Joint Workshop with the Tulare County Planning Commission and receive a presentation by County Counsel on Due Process, Entanglement, Bias and Conflict of Interest in discretionary Land Use Matters.

SUMMARY:

The Tulare County Planning Commission is a "first level" decision-maker on property owner applications for discretionary land use entitlements, such as special use permits, variances, surface mining permits, subdivision maps, and parcel maps. Decisions by the Planning Commission may be appealed to the Board of Supervisors.

The decisions by both bodies in these matters are subject to constitutional Procedure Due Process requirements and questions regarding entanglement, bias and conflict of interest may sometimes arise.

The last training provided by County Counsel to the Board of Supervisors and the Planning Commission on this process and these questions was in 2001. Since that

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time, there has been a significant change in membership in both bodies and the law in this area has continued to evolve. Consequently, this joint workshop was scheduled so that County Counsel could make a presentation to the Board and Planning Commission on these matters.
