#### SUBJECT:

Acceptance of the California Integrated Waste Management Board for the Household Hazardous Waste Grant (17<sup>th</sup> Cycle).

#### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Ratify and approve the acceptance of the California Integrated Waste Management Board for the Household Hazardous Waste Grant (17<sup>th</sup> Cycle) in the amount of \$99,732 for the purchase of approved sharps containers for home generated sharps waste, retroactive to October 2008 through April 15, 2011. This grant is retroactive because the submittal of the grant application to the State and notification to the County of the grant award occurred after the beginning of the grant term. It was impracticable for the Board to take action before October 2008 due to the time needed to process, prepare, and submit the Agenda Item.
- 2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed agreement as of October 2008 and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date.
- 3. Approve the necessary budget adjustments per the attached AUD 308 (4/5ths vote required).
- 4. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign three (3) copies of the agreement.

#### **SUMMARY:**

California Health and Safety Code Section 118286 prohibits disposal of homegenerated sharps waste in the trash on or after September 1, 2008. "Homegenerated sharps waste" is hypodermic needles, lancets, and other devices derived from a household. This section further requires that all home-generated sharps waste must be transported in an approved sharps container to authorized disposal locations. This grant application proposes the purchase of approved sharps containers for distribution to the public, and partnerships with pharmacies, medical providers, and diabetes education and support groups for outreach and education to underserved populations. Disposal kiosks will be established at Tulare County Health Centers to receive home-generated sharps waste from the public.

We would like to bring the following items to the Board's attention that deviate from County Contract Protocol: Section 34 calls for the County to indemnify the State, which is a standard provision in State agreements and Section 64 calls for the County to waive all claims against the State for acts related to the agreement, which is a standard provision in this agreement.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

The Grant term is October 2008 through April 15, 2011. The Grant allocates Tulare County a total amount of \$99,732 for the grant term. Funding in the amount of \$12,500 for Fiscal Year 2008/2009 was not included in this year's budget. The Fiscal Year 2008/2009 budget will be adjusted by the Board's approval of the attached AUD 308 budget adjustment form. Subsequent years will have the Grant funding included in the expenditures and revenues.

#### LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

Strategic Initiative 3: Quality of Life, Goal to promote a litter-free Tulare County. The objective of this grant is to educate and assist the public on the proper way to handle household sharps waste.

#### **ALTERNATIVES:**

Not to accept grant funds or conduct the proposed activities to divert householdgenerated sharps waste from County landfills.

#### **INVOLVEMENT OF OTHER DEPARTMENTS OR AGENCIES:**

This regional grant includes the County of Tulare and the cities of Dinuba, Exeter, Farmersville, Lindsay, Porterville, Tulare, Visalia and Woodlake.
