#### **SUMMARY:**

In light of the current economic state of our nation, and the growing budget crisis in the State of California, the Community Disaster Partner (CDP) Task Force has identified the current and potential future impacts the economic and budget crisis may have on Tulare County. The CDP, which evolved from the Freeze Relief Task Force, aligns community based organizations, private sector organizations, and local government agencies that stand as the safety net, the second responders to disaster. The Task Force includes CSET, Workforce Investment Board, United Way of Tulare County, Proteus, Inc., EDD, Porterville Chamber of Commerce, and Visalia Chamber of Commerce, among others. By collecting and analyzing data from each CDP member, the Task Force has identified that the need for housing, food, employment, and utility assistance may rise significantly if the economic crisis worsens. The CDP has been working to outline the potential needs of our community should the State Controller continue to hold back vital funding, and


