SUBJECT: Application for continued grant funding from the California Emergency Management Agency for the Special Emphasis Victim Assistance Program.

REQUEST(S):
That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Ratify the submission of the application for continued grant funding from the California Emergency Management Agency for the Special Emphasis Victim Assistance Program in the amount of \$110,000 for Fiscal Year 2009/2010.
2. Ratify the Board Chairman's signature on the Face Sheet Agreement and all grant application documents necessary to secure grant funds.

SUMMARY:
California Emergency Management Agency (CalEMA) issued a Request for Application for the Special Emphasis Victim Assistance (SEVA) Program for the fiscal year 2009/2010. The purpose of the SEVA Program is to provide mandated services to Spanish-speaking victims of violent crime in Tulare County.

The SEVA Program provides decentralized services through existing community service centers in Visalia and Porterville, as well as by interacting with law enforcement agencies to facilitate services in rural areas.

The program receives referrals from all local law enforcement agencies, as well as our own Deputy District Attorney's, Child Protective Services, funeral homes,

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hospitals, rape crisis centers, domestic violence shelters, and other service providers.

In order to increase program awareness throughout the County, staff networks with other agencies and service providers, and attends interagency meeting, health fairs, and related events. The program is promoted through radio, newspaper, and television PSAs.

The SEVA program provides Spanish-speaking victims with services such as crisis intervention, court support, case status and update, assistance in filing for benefits from the Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board, and orientation to the criminal justice system.

The program involves the dedication of 2.0 FTE Spanish-speaking Victim Witness Workers/Advocates, 1.0 FTE Spanish-speaking Legal Office Assistant, and 0.25 FTE Project Coordinator. The grant period will be July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The total project cost is \$137,500. The grant allocation is expected to be \$110,000 with a \$27,500 match, which will be included in the FY 2009/2010 budget for the Office of the District Attorney. This funding level is consistent with that of previous years, and there will be no additional net County cost.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year Strategic Business Plan and Management System include Safety and Security initiatives to provide for the safety and security of the public. Continued grant funding from CalEMA helps to fulfill this initiative. Through the Special Emphasis Victim Assistance Program, dedicated staff provide services to victims of crime, including supportive services throughout the criminal justice proceedings, and by connecting them with financial assistance through the Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board.




VII. Special Condition for Grant Awards with Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Fund


