# REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Reaffirm Resolution No. 2009-0332, adopted May 5, 2009.

## **SUMMARY:**

This agenda is to reaffirm Resolution No. 2009-0332, adopted May 5, 2009, declaring a local health emergency based on the H1N1 Swine Influenza contracted in Tulare County. The World Health Organization had raised the pandemic alert level to five, indicating widespread human infection and that a pandemic is imminent. Reaffirmation of this Proclamation will allow Tulare County to take all the necessary actions to obtain aid from State and Federal officials and minimize regulatory burden to provide relief in the event accumulated economic losses are recoverable. In addition, Tulare County will have the requisite declaration in place to file a claim and that a copy of the resolution will be forwarded to all appropriate agencies.
