Authorize new Sheriff's positions for the Tulare County Clandestine Laboratory Enforcement Team program

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Authorize and approve a personnel resolution to create one Sheriff's sergeant position and three Sheriff's detective positions for the Tulare County Clandestine Laboratory Enforcement Unit (CLEU) program.

SUMMARY:

On May 5, 2009, your Board accepted funding from the California Emergency Management Agency (Cal-EMA) to continue the Tulare County Clandestine Laboratory Enforcement Unit (CLEU) program through June 30, 2010. Cal-EMA funds CLEU through the agency's California Multi-Jurisdictional Methamphetamine Enforcement Team (Cal-MMET) grant program.

For accounting purposes, the Sheriff's Department is returning to the Board today to authorize creation of new employee position numbers for the CLEU program staff. The department's team members on CLEU will fill these new positions. The funding agency — Cal-EMA — has endorsed this approach. This practice will allow the department to avoid any appearance of supplanting grant funds to operate the program.

The Sheriff's Department has operated CLEU since 2001 with state funding. CLEU is a partnership of the Sheriff's Department, Tulare County District Attorney's Office,

and various law enforcement units. CLEU has been responsible for shutting down scores of illegal methamphetamine laboratories in the County; confiscating more than 65,000 grams of meth and more than 200,000 grams of cocaine, heroin, marijuana and component chemicals of meth; and putting numerous large and small drug traffickers behind bars.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The attached Personnel Resolution will establish four new positions for the Sheriff's Department to operate the CLEU program.

There will be no net County cost to operate the CLEU program.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The Tulare County Strategic Business Plan includes a Security and Safety Initiative. The CLEU program is in line with this initiative through the investigation, arrest and prosecution of illegal drug manufacturer and sales in Tulare County.
