Notice of Completion for Construction of Visalia Landfill Phase 2 Expansion

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Accept the work for construction of Visalia Landfill Phase 2 Expansion as complete by Wood Bros. Incorporated of Lemoore, California;
- 2. Authorize the Chairman to sign the Notice of Completion; and
- 3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to have the Notice of Completion recorded with the County Recorder.

SUMMARY:

This Notice of Completion is for the construction of Visalia Landfill Phase 2 Expansion. The work was performed by Wood Bros. Incorporated under Tulare County Agreement No. 23494.

The project was approved by your Board for advertisement on January 29, 2008. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Wood Bros. Incorporated. On April 22, 2008, your Board awarded and approved (Resolution No. 2008-0235) a contract to Wood Bros. Incorporated of Lemoore, California in the amount of \$8,596,334.34 (which includes a five percent (5%) contingency).

The Visalia Landfill, owned and operated by the County, must be expanded laterally to continue operation. The work done consisted of earthwork, geosynthetic liners

and leachate collection and removal systems installation for the expansion of the Visalia Landfill. This work covers approximately 32 acres.

There were three (3) change orders written for this project. The first change order, in the amount of \$108,700.16, was written to remove unsuitable material (sand) located below the liner. It was determined during excavation that there were areas where sand was present of an unsuitable nature for the deployment of the liner. As a result, the sand was removed and replaced with engineered fill material. The second change order, in the amount of \$1,000, was written to construct a dirt diversion berm to carry storm water away from the sump and into an area where the run-off will eventually evaporate. Without this change, run-off entering the sump would have required pumping to get rid of the water. The third change order, in the amount of \$98,815, was written to compensate the contractor for the delay in the progress of the work. Liner material samples were submitted for quality control testing. The test results indicated the sample material did not meet contract specifications therefore the contractor could not install the liner. Additional testing was performed when changes in liner production and different methods for liner placement were considered. The additional time it took to perform these tests, that were necessary to satisfy the regulatory agencies, caused a delay in the progress of work resulting in a claim from the contractor.

The total cost of the change orders is within the five percent (5%) contingency (\$409,349.26) approved by the Board for this project.

This project has been completed in accordance with the plans and specifications and is now ready for acceptance by the Board. Acceptance of the completion of this contract will allow release of all payments due to Wood Bros. Incorporated for the work performed.

5% Contingency 409,349.26
Amount Authorized by the Board: \$8,596,334.36

Final Estimated Project Cost \$8,402,738.96

There is no net County cost to the General Fund. Funding for this expenditure will be from the Solid Waste Enterprise Fund.




