SUBJECT:

Election of the Seventh Member and the Alternate Seventh Member of the Tulare County Employees' Retirement Board

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve the Resolution to call an election to fill the position of the Seventh Member and the Alternate Seventh Member on the Tulare County Employees' Retirement Board for the three (3) year term commencing on January 1, 2010; and
- 2. Adopt the Resolution regarding the election procedures for the Seventh Member and the Alternate Seventh Member.

SUMMARY:

Government Code Section 31520.1 states that the Seventh Member of the Tulare County Employees' Retirement Board shall be an active safety member of the Retirement Association, elected by the safety members representing qualified Law Enforcement and Fire Suppression members of the Retirement Association.

The Alternate Seventh Member as defined by Government Code Section 31520.1 shall be that candidate from the groups under Government Code Sections 31470.2 and 31470.4 who receives the second highest number of votes in the election for the Seventh Member, and who is not part of the same group of safety employees as the person elected as the Seventh Member.

Since the term of the present Seventh Member and Alternate Seventh Member on the Retirement Board will expire on December 31, 2009, it is necessary to call an SUBJECT: Election of the Seventh Member and the Alternate Seventh Member of

election to fill those positions for the three (3) year term commencing on January 1, 2010.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

All costs associated with the Election will be paid for by the Tulare County Employees' Retirement Association.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year Strategic Business Plan includes the Organizational Performance Initiative to continuously improve organizational effectiveness and fiscal stability. This Election helps fulfill this initiative by providing the Retirement Board with a quorum to help in the effective communication, collaboration and decision-making process of their Board.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Board could chose not to hold the Election for the terms ending December 31, 2009; however, this could potentially result in the Retirement Board having to cancel a meeting due to the lack of a quorum.

WHEREAS, members of the Board of Retirement are elected or appointed in accordance with section 31520.1 of the Government Code and Section 31520.1 states that the Seventh Member and the Alternate Seventh Member of the Board shall be safety members of the Retirement Association, elected by the safety members representing qualified Law Enforcement and Fire Suppression members of the Retirement Association; and

WHEREAS, under Section 31520.1 it will be necessary to elect a Second, Seventh and Alternate Member of the Board of Retirement; and

WHEREAS, for convenience, this Resolution only pertains to the election of the Seventh Member and Alternate Seventh Member of the Board, and the procedure for election of the Second Member is covered by another Resolution adopted this same date;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. This Board hereby calls an election to be held to fill the office of the Seventh Member and Alternate Seventh Member of the Board of Retirement for a three (3) year term commencing on January 1, 2010.
- 2. The Alternate Seventh Member as defined by Section 31520.1 shall be that candidate from the groups under Sections 31470.2 and 31470.4 who receives the second highest number of votes in the election for the Seventh Member, and who is not part of the same group of Safety employees as the person elected as the Seventh Member.
- 3. Notice of said election shall be sent to all eligible members of the Retirement Association by the Clerk of this Board as soon as possible after the adoption of this resolution, and shall be in the form which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.
- 4. Any safety member of the Retirement Association who will be a safety member on and after September 10, 2009 is eligible for nomination to fill said vacancy. Nominations shall be made by Nomination Papers which may be obtained from the Clerk of the Board at the Administration Building, 2800 West Burrel, Visalia. The Nomination Papers shall be in

the form attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and incorporated herein by reference. Each candidate shall be nominated by at least ten (10) persons who are safety members of the Retirement Association at the time the Nomination Papers are filed.

- 5. Nominations of candidates shall be filed with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors. Nominations may be filed from and after the adoption of this Resolution but not later than 5:00 p.m. on September 25, 2009.
- 6. Candidates may file with their nomination papers a statement of 200 words or less setting forth their qualifications for the Retirement Board, their reasons for desiring to sit on the Board and any other information pertinent to the person and his or her candidacy. Notification of the right to submit such statements shall be included in the notice described in Paragraph 3.
- 7. No candidate may withdraw his or her Nomination Papers after they have been filed with the Clerk as provided in paragraph 5 above.
- 8. If only one qualified person has been nominated for the position of Seventh Member as of the close of nominations on September 25, 2009, the Board of Supervisors shall order that no election be held and shall direct the Clerk to cast a unanimous ballot in favor of said candidate. In such case, there shall be no Alternate Seventh Member elected.
- 9. If the election has been, or is to be, canceled in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 8 above, the provisions of this paragraph shall be of no effect, and the provisions of this paragraph shall not be deemed to require that the election be held. If the election has not been, and is not to be, canceled in accordance with paragraph 8 above, any safety member of the Retirement Association who has not been nominated prior to the deadline set forth in paragraph 5 above who desires to have his or her name written in by voters on ballots for the election shall file a statement with the Clerk of Board of Supervisors stating that he/she is a write-in candidate for election to the position. Said statement shall be filed with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors no later than 5:00 p.m. on October 2, 2009. No name written in on a ballot shall be counted unless said statement has been filed with the Clerk.
- 10. After the close of the nomination period on October 2, 2009, the Clerk of the Board shall cause official ballots to be printed for use in said election. The form of the ballot shall be substantially as set forth in Exhibit "C" which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. The names of the candidates shall be listed on the ballot in the alphabetical order of their last names. The person who prints the official ballots for the Clerk shall certify to this Board the total number of ballots printed.

- 11. The Clerk shall also prepare a notice which shall be submitted to each voter with the ballot. The candidates' statements submitted pursuant to paragraph 6 shall be attached to said notice. The form of the notice shall be substantially in the form designated as Exhibit "D" which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- 12. Except under the circumstances mentioned in paragraph 9 above, the required election shall be held during the period beginning on the date that the Clerk mails or otherwise sends the ballots and ending at 1:00 p.m. on November 13, 2009. Said election shall be conducted by secret ballot with each person who is a safety member of the Retirement Association on September 10, 2009, being eligible to cast a vote for this office.
- 13. No later than October 15, 2009, the Clerk of the Board shall send to each person eligible to vote in the election a ballot and notice in the form attached hereto as Exhibits "C" and "D". The Clerk shall determine the names of the persons entitled to vote for the Seventh Member of the Board from the files of the Human Resources & Development Department with the advice and assistance of the Retirement Administrator. The Clerk shall enclose with said ballot and notice a self-addressed envelope for return of the ballot, or the ballot may be returned by inter-office mail.
- 14. When the mailing of ballots to all eligible voters has been completed, the Clerk of the Board shall destroy all extra ballots which were printed and the Clerk shall file a certificate with this Board stating the total number of ballots mailed and stating the number of surplus ballots which have been destroyed.
- 15. As the Clerk receives envelopes with ballots enclosed from the voters, the envelopes shall be stored, unopened, in a safe place until the time for opening ballots set forth in paragraph 16 below.
- 16. On November 13, 2009, commencing at 1:00 p.m., the Clerk of the Board shall open all of the sealed envelopes and count the votes cast for the respective candidates. The opening of the envelopes and counting of ballots shall be done in the Administration Building, 2800 West Burrel, Visalia, and any interested person is entitled to view the entire proceedings.
- 17. If any ballot contains distinguishing marks or erasures, as those terms have been defined under State law, such ballot shall be declared void and not counted. If any envelope contains any distinguishing marks or a return address, the envelope shall be opened and discarded and the ballot placed with other uncounted ballots in such a manner that the identity of the person casting the ballot cannot be ascertained.

18. Any ballot received by the Clerk after the hour of 1:00 p.m. on November 13, 2009, regardless of the date when it was mailed, shall not be opened nor counted, and the unopened envelope shall be placed with the void ballots. The Clerk shall also accept ballots delivered other than by mail as long as they are received by 1:00 p.m. on November 13, 2009.

- 19. As soon as the counting of ballots is completed, the Clerk shall make public the number of votes received by each candidate.
- 20. The Clerk of this Board shall certify the results of the election to the Board of Supervisors at their regular meeting on December 1, 2009. The candidate with the largest number of votes for the office shall be declared elected Seventh Member by the Board of Supervisors and the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall thereafter issue a certificate of election to the person elected for the term of office established under section 31520.1 of the Government Code. However, if the votes are tied, the winner will be selected by lot.
- 21. The candidate from the groups under Sections 31470.2 and 31470.4 who is the person that receives the second highest number of votes and who is part of the group of Safety employees not represented by the Seventh Member shall be declared the Alternate Safety Member.
- 22. If any interested party wishes to challenge the validity of any ballot, or the results of the election as certified by the Clerk of the Board, the objecting party shall present his or her contentions to the Board of Supervisors, in writing, prior to 9:00 a.m. on December 1, 2009. The Board of Supervisors shall take such action as necessary in order to resolve the dispute and the decision of the Board of Supervisors shall be final.
- 23. The Clerk shall store all ballots received, including void ballots and unopened envelopes, in a safe place for a period of four (4) months after the date of the election, at which time the Clerk may cause them to be destroyed.
- 24. If the winning candidate dies, resigns, or is otherwise incapacitated before his or her term of office commences, a new election will be called.
- 25. If a vacancy occurs after the term of office commences for the Seventh Member, the Alternate Seventh Member shall become the Seventh Member until the term for the Seventh Member expires.
- 26. If a vacancy occurs in the position of the Alternate Seventh Member because the member becomes the Seventh Member or the member dies, resigns, or is otherwise incapacitated before his or her term of office, the Board of Retirement may leave the position

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Since the term of office for the Seventh Member and the Alternate Seventh Member of the Board of Retirement will expire on December 31, 2009, an election has been called by the Tulare County Board of Supervisors to fill those positions for the 3-year term commencing on January 1, 2010. The Alternate Seventh Member shall that person who receives the next highest number of votes for election of the Seventh Member and who is not part of the same group of Safety employees as the person elected as Seventh Member.

RULES OF PROCEDURE FOR CANDIDATES

- 1. Ten (10) valid signatures of safety members of the Tulare County Employees' Retirement Association are required to nominate a candidate, including the incumbent if the incumbent intends to become a candidate for re-election. Nominating Papers may be obtained from the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors at the Administration Building, 2800 West Burrel, Visalia. The Nominating Papers must be returned to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors by 5:00 p.m. on September 25, 2009. Candidates may submit with their Nominating Papers a candidate's statement of 200 words or less relating to their candidacy for the Board of Retirement. Only safety members of the Association are entitled to be candidates, or vote, for the office of Seventh Member and Alternate Seventh Member of the Retirement Board.
- 2. A declaration of Candidacy cannot be withdrawn once it has been filed with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.
- 3. If only one (1) person files Nomination Papers, including but not limited to the incumbent, no election will be held and that person will be declared elected.
- 4. If two (2) or more persons file Nomination Papers, the election will be held. In addition there will be a seven (7) day period from September 28, 2009 to October 2, 2009 at 5:00 p.m. to allow persons who want to be write-in candidates to file a statement with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors that they are "write-in" candidates. No name written in on a ballot will be counted unless this statement has been filed with the Clerk. This statement may be filed by mail or in person.
- 5. Any safety member who wishes a copy of the Resolution calling the election which sets out the complete details and rules of procedure for conducting the election may obtain one, without cost, by contacting the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, Administration Building, 2800 West Burrel, Visalia, California 93291, and asking for said Resolution.
- 6. The election period will be from the date the Clerk mails or otherwise sends the ballots until November 13, 2009 at 1:00 p.m. Ballots will be sent out on or before October 15, 2009 to all eligible voters.
- 7. Please report any change in address and/or workstation, or correction in writing to the Board of Retirement, 136 N. Akers Street, Visalia, California 93291, so that you can exercise your right to vote. Ballots will be mailed to the address on this envelope unless you notify the Board of a change or correction. There will not be any duplicate or extra ballots available for persons who do not receive their ballots.

Only those safety members of the Association who were safety members on and after September 10, 2009 are entitled to cast ballots for candidates for the office of Seventh Member of the Retirement Board.

Votes for write-in candidates for the office will not be counted, under the rules adopted by the Board of Supervisors, unless the person desiring to have his/her name written in by voters filed a statement with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors stating that he or she was a write-in candidate for election to the office no later than October 2, 2009. A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for you to return your ballot by mail, or in inter-office mail. You may, if you wish, personally deliver your ballot in the ballot envelope to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors. Ballots <u>must be received</u> by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, Administration Building, 2800 West Burrel, Visalia, no later than 1:00 p.m. on November 13, 2009 in order to be valid.
