Agreement with the California Table Grape Export Association

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an agreement with the California Table Grape Export Association to provide advanced digital imaging equipment to the Tulare County Agricultural Commissioner.

SUMMARY:

The California Table Grape Export Association has acquired advanced digital imaging equipment through a U.S. Department of Agriculture Technical Assistance for Specialty Crops (TASC) grant. The equipment will be utilized to provide pest identification in support of the pre-clearance export programs for California table grapes destined to Australia and New Zealand. The Agricultural Commissioner will house and maintain the equipment until either the Board of Supervisors or Association terminates the Agreement.

The following provisions of the Agreement deviate from the standard County Contract Protocol as it is funded by a federal pass-through grant, the U.S. Department of Agriculture Technical Assistance for Specialty Crops (TASC) Grant:

1) Term: The term of the agreement is indefinite, until terminated by either party.

2) Indemnification: The agreement does not include an indemnity provision.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The agreement was prepared by the California Table Grape Export Association and will result in receipt of financial aid to the County in the form of \$39,492.12 worth of equipment if this agreement is approved. There is no net county cost associated with the acceptance of this equipment.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Economic Well-Being Initiative to promote economic development opportunities, effective growth management and a quality standard of living. This request to authorize an agreement between the California Table Grape Export Association and the Tulare County Board of Supervisors will insure a long-standing program of protecting the County's agriculture-based economy by assuring rapid identification of pests.

ALTERNATIVES:

No action or disapproval would mean that the Agricultural Commissioner would not be able to receive the benefit of using state-of-the-art identification equipment provided by the California Table Grape Export Association.
