Accept donations for the Tulare County Animal Control Shelter to expand the enclosure designated for Cats.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Accept funds and materials donated from Friends of Tulare County, designated for the cat enclosure at the Tulare County Animal Control Shelter.

SUMMARY:

Individuals who have concern about the housing of cats at the Tulare County Animal Control Shelter have expressed their desire to provide materials and funds to see an adequate enclosure constructed for cats at the Shelter. In addition, these same contributors desire to donate their time to assist with the construction of the enclosure. The resources for the cattery have been generously given and pledged to the Friends of Tulare County, a non-profit organization whose aim is to enhance county services.

Tulare County Animal Control Shelter currently houses an average of 250 cats per month. The present enclosure does not allow adequate room for visitors to interact with the cats. Many of the visitors who present at the Shelter are there to inquire about adopting a pet. The donors and staff feel the potential for visitors seeking to adopt a cat would be better served if there was an area that is safe and secure for them to interact with the cats. By having an area that is better suited for the visitors to become acquainted with the cats, we feel this would allow for a much greater

success rate in the adoptions. The improvements to the enclosure will not interfere with the daily operations of the Shelter.

All time donated by the individuals will be served under the oversight of a licensed construction manager and follow all County Building Codes. The project will ultimately result in a direct reduction of the expenses borne by Tulare County for the care and feeding of the animals that are awaiting adoptions.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:
