REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Approve a letter of recommendation for Mario Santoyo to be appointed to the California Water Commission.

SUMMARY:

In November 2009, after extensive debate and negotiations, the California Legislature adopted a multi-bill package of laws designed to address statewide water supply issues and Sacramento River Delta protection. The Governor signed all five of the bills into law. One of those bills placed an \$11 billion bond on the November 2010 California Ballot.

The California Water Commission will have a very large impact on how funding from the bond is allocated. Three billion dollars will be appropriated to the Commission for public benefits associated with water storage projects that improve the operation of the state water system. The Commission will rank potential projects based on the expected return for public investment. Projects eligible for funding through the Commission include surface storage projects, groundwater storage projects, ecosystem improvements, water quality improvements in the Delta or other systems and flood control benefits, among others.

Given the role the California Water Commission will play in allocating \$3 billion in bond funds, it is extremely important Tulare County have a representative on the Commission. Tulare County will greatly benefit by having someone advocate for projects that benefit its residents.
