REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- Approve the necessary budget adjustments per the attached AUD 308 (4/5ths vote required) for the 2009-10 H1N1 Supplemental Allocation from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Public Health Emergency Response Phase I and II (CDC PHER) and Hospital Preparedness H1N1 (HPP H1N1) funds; and
- 2. Approve the fixed asset purchase of a Nor-Lake Scientific Refrigerator for the Tulare County Public Health Emergency Preparedness in the amount of \$5,365.

SUMMARY:

On December 15, 2009, the Tulare County Board of Supervisors approved Tulare County Agreement No. 24362 (State Agreement No. EPO 09-54) for the Comprehensive Agreement with the California Department of Public Health, Emergency Preparedness Office via Resolution No. 2009-1083. Trust Fund 559 was established for CDC PHER H1N1 Phase I and Phase II funding for the amount

of \$441,112. The total amount of \$441,112 was appropriated to Object No. 2200.

This agenda item is requesting to re-appropriate a portion of the funds to personnel and operating budget expense object lines to carry out H1N1 Phase I and II functions. Operating expenses include personal protective equipment for county clinic staff, printing of H1N1 materials and extra personnel expenses for Public Health Lab personnel performing H1N1 testing.

The fixed asset request is for purchase of a pharmaceutical grade refrigerator to store H1N1 vaccine in accordance with State guidelines for temperature and monitoring requirements.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

Through the Board's approval of the attached AUD 308 budget adjustment form, the Fiscal Year 2009/2010 revenue and expenditures will be adjusted accordingly. No Net County Cost.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Safety and Security Initiative to plan and provide coordinated emergency preparedness response, recovery and mitigation capabilities for natural and manmade disasters. Approval for the purchase of a pharmaceutical grade refrigerator to store H1N1 vaccine and to reappropriate a portion of the funds to personnel and operating budget expense object lines to carry out H1N1 Phase I and II functions helps fulfill this initiative by ensuring the County is prepared to respond to and recover from bioterrorist activities, Pandemic Influenza, other communicable disease outbreaks, and other public health threats and disasters.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Board could choose to not approve this purchase and the re-appropriation of this funding which would preclude the agency from recovering costs incurred in H1N1 response expenses. This alternative is not recommended as the Board has consistently supported public health emergency preparedness for the people of Tulare County and selection of this alternative would result in a severe decrease or elimination of Tulare County's ability to respond and recover in the event of bioterrorist activities, a pandemic or other public health threat or emergency.
