That the Board of Supervisors:

Receive a presentation regarding an overview of the Tulare County Transit System.

SUMMARY:

Tulare County Area Transit (TCAT) is the County of Tulare's rural transit service which serves 38 Tulare County cities and communities. Recent increases in ridership and service expansion will be detailed in the presentation. The addition of a County-wide T-Pass has increased ridership and improved customer service. The addition of Proposition 1B funds (Prop 1B) and Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Rural Transit funds (Section 5311) for capital projects has allowed the upgrading and modernization of the transit fleet and infrastructure. Other accomplishments will also be presented.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

Transit expansion has been funded with Measure R, Prop 1B and 5311 funds. There is no net county cost to the general fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year Strategic Plan includes the Safety and Security initiative which addresses improving and maintaining an adequate transportation infrastructure. Tulare County Area Transit helps with the achieving of this goal.
