SUBJECT: Capital Projects – History of Farm Labor and Agriculture Museum Elevator Project

REQUEST(S):
That the Board of Supervisors:
1) Award the contract in the amount of \$89,980 for the History of Farm Labor and Agriculture Museum Elevator Project to the lowest responsible bidder, Webb and Son Corp., 678 N. Plano, Porterville, CA 93257; and
2) Authorize the Chairman to sign the construction agreement subject to review and approval as to form by County Counsel and upon receipt of certificates of insurance, bonds and evidence that the Contractor possesses a valid State contractor's license.

SUMMARY:
The History of Farm Labor and Agriculture Museum Elevator Project bids were opened on March 4, 2010.

A total of two bids were received and opened, with the low bid in the amount \$89,980 being submitted by Webb and Son Corporation, a Porterville based construction firm.

The Project will consist of a new 4000 lb hydraulic two stop elevator that will provide ADA access to the Mezzanine and shelled areas of the second floor of the Museum.

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A recap of the bids is below:

BIDDER	AMOUNT
Webb and Son	\$89,980
Gary Interrante Construction	\$94,000

It is recommended that the project be awarded to Webb and Son for a total contract amount of \$89,980.

Upon award of the project, a Notice to Proceed will be issued with the project slated to start on March 29, 2010. The Project duration is 175 calendar days, and completion is scheduled for September 20, 2010.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The project is funded in the Capital Projects Fund 030-086-3200-5336. The Project was estimated at \$105,000.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The project links well with the Economic Well-Being and Quality of Life Strategic Initiatives by promoting tourist opportunities, strengthening Tulare County's historical heritage, providing additional educational, recreational and cultural opportunities.


ALTERNATIVES:
