SUBJECT: Facilities – Approval to Waive Competitive Bid Process

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Waive the competitive bid process to allow additional purchases in FY 2009/2010 with ADI Inc. a Low Voltage Equipment Vendor.

SUMMARY:

ADI is a low voltage parts supplier, which the County of Tulare uses extensively. The County of Tulare purchases low voltage supplies to keep our detention facility camera systems and electronic lock systems operating. ADI provides the County of Tulare with low voltage parts and supplies far below the price we pay at other locations. We have reached the contract limit in purchases for Fiscal Year 2009/2010, and need to increase the limit by approximately \$20,000 for the remainder of the fiscal year depending on facility needs. Future fiscal year purchases for these commodities will bid by the Purchasing Agent.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The ADI account is budgeted in the Facilities account line 067-067-3010-2100.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

Waiving the competitive bid process will link to the Safety and Security and the Organizational Performance Strategic Initiative by providing adequate facilities for
