REQUEST(S):
That the Board of Supervisors:
Receive the 2009 Tulare County Annual Crop and Livestock Report and a brief presentation by the Agricultural Commissioner regarding its contents.

SUMMARY:
The 2009 Tulare County Annual Crop and Livestock Report is produced in accordance with Sections 2272 and 2279 of the California Food and Agricultural Code and summarizes the acreage, production, and value of Tulare County's agricultural commodities. The figures contained therein represent gross returns to the producer and do not reflect actual net profit. The Commissioner will present the report to the Board of Supervisors, and offer brief comments and observations regarding its contents.

Approximately 1,500 copies of the Annual Crop and Livestock Report are disseminated to the media, legislators, and business. These statistics form the basis of crop values for disaster relief efforts and are used by decision-makers and a wide variety of financial institutions, insurance companies, or others who need to know the value of our local agricultural commodities.

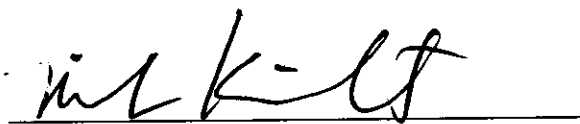
