Approval of amendment to Agreement No. 4860 and approval of new agreement with Richard Fair, M.D. to provide on-call medical services for Tulare County Health & Human Services Agency clients.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Ratify and approve the Tulare County Purchasing Agent amending Professional Services Agreement No. 4860 with Richard Fair, M.D., to increase the maximum amount of the agreement by \$50,000 from \$100,000 to \$150,000 for the provision of providing on-call medical services for Tulare County Health & Human Services Agency clients, retroactive to July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010. This amendment is retroactive due to an increase in the on-call medical services required of Dr. Fair realized earlier this year and inadvertent delays in obtaining authorized signatures on the amendment. It was impracticable for the Board to take action before July 1, 2009 due to the time needed to process, prepare, and submit the agenda item;

This agreement is retroactive due to inadvertent delays in obtaining authorized signatures on the agreement. It was impracticable for the Board to take action before January 1, 2010 due to the time needed to process, prepare, and submit the agenda item:

SUMMARY:

The Tulare County Health & Human Services Agency (HHSA) provides medical services to citizens of Tulare County. Dr. Richard Fair provides OB/GYN services from time to time as requested by the Director of Health or his staff. The physician performs the services in a manner consistent with the level of care and skill ordinarily exercised by other like professionals practicing in the State of California under similar circumstances. With the county-wide shortage of OB/GYN providers, it is essential that we continue to have the access and ability to use qualified providers to help fill our provider shortages. Dr. Fair fills a requirement needed for Tulare County.

It was realized earlier this year that it would be necessary require an increase in the services provided by Dr. Fair. As a result, the original amount of \$100,000 for Agreement No. 4860 was not sufficient to cover the expenses through June 30, 2010. HHSA has determined that this increase in services would require the need to request an increase in the maximum amount of the Agreement No. 4860 by \$50,000 from \$100,000 to \$150,000. It addition, HHSA is also requesting the approval of an agreement with Dr. Fair in the amount of \$520,000 to allow Dr. Fair to continue to provide services through June 30, 2011.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The maximum reimbursement for Professional Services Agreement No. 4860 for Fiscal Year 2009/2010 (July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010) through the Board's approval of this request will be increased by \$50,000 from \$100,000 to \$150,000. This amount of \$150,000 is included in the Fiscal Year 2009/2010 budget.

The maximum reimbursement for the proposed agreement is \$520,000 from January 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. \$120,000 of the \$520,000 is budgeted for expenses from January 1, 2010 through June 30, 2010. This amount of \$120,000 is included in the Fiscal Year 2009/2010 budget. The remaining amount of \$400,000 for Fiscal Year 2010/2011 will be included in the Fiscal Year 2010/2011 proposed
