Freeze of Allocated Positions and Funding for Public Defender

Office Investigations Unit.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve the reduction of 5 Public Defender Investigators/Investigators-Bilingual positions (2 vacant, 3 filled), effective July 9, 2010.
- 2. Direct the Public Defender and Human Resources and Development Department to initiate the layoff process, including issuance of notices of layoff.
- Authorize the freeze of vacant but allocated positions in the Investigations
 Unit.

SUMMARY:

For Fiscal Year 2010-2011, the recommended budget of the CAO will reduce the Public Defender's budget by 4% on top of 7.5% reductions incurred in fiscal year 2009-2010. In order to meet these further decreases while maintaining current levels of service to all Public Defender clients and the Tulare County Superior Court, the Public Defender proposes to reduce the Investigations Unit by 55% which includes vacating and freezing a total of five investigator positions and eliminating one extra-help Investigative Aide. These proposed savings will allow the Department to meet the CAO's proposed budget reductions and to fund

Professional and Specialized/Special Investigative Services as needed.

The vacant/frozen positions include one Investigator II, two Investigator I's, one Investigator II-Bilingual, and one Investigator I-Bilingual. The Department will also eliminate one extra-help Investigative Aide.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

These actions will help the Department meet the requisite budget reduction of \$337,775 for fiscal year 2010-2011.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

This action supports the Organizational Performance Initiative in the County's Strategic Business Plan. The initiative provides for the stability of County operations through periods of economic fluctuations and changing priorities and service demands.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Board could choose to maintain the current level of Investigative resources and maintain current levels of funding for the Public Defender department or direct the Department to reduce expenditures in other areas.
