### **SUBJECT**:

Approval of amendment to Agreement No. 22797 with Turning Point of Central California, Inc. for the One-Stop Center – North County Program.

### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an amendment to Agreement No. 22797 with Turning Point of Central California, Inc. for the One-Stop Center North County Program in an amount not to exceed \$725,066 to extend the term of the agreement to June 30, 2011, for the provision of Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) services; and
- 2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign three (3) copies of the amendment.

### **SUMMARY:**

Under Agreement No. 22797, Turning Point of Central California, Inc. provides mental health services per the State regulations governing MHSA programs to mental health consumers in Tulare County through the One-Stop Center – North County program.

The One-Stop Center – North County Program is designed to offer a wide array of services to children, youth and transitional age youth (TAY). The One-Stop program employs a Children System of Care Model that promotes the integration of mental

health services and quality of life approaches such as employment, education, drug/alcohol counseling, and life skills training.

Turning Point of Central California, Inc. provides all services under the administrative oversight of Tulare County. Agreement No. 22797 will expire on June 30, 2010. The purpose of this amendment is to extend the term of the agreement to June 30, 2011.

### FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

Funding in an amount not to exceed \$725,066 for this agreement will be included in the Fiscal Year 2010/2011 proposed budget and are paid through Medi-Cal and Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) revenues. No Net County Cost.

# LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year plan includes the Quality of Life initiative to promote and encourage the provision of quality supportive services for individuals in Tulare County. Tulare County children and youth will benefit from the provision of mental health services by Turning Point of Central California, Inc.

### **ALTERNATIVES:**

The Board could choose not to approve this Amendment; this would result in the loss of mental health services to those clients currently or potentially served under the MHSA programs as these services are not currently available through the County's traditional mental health services.
