**SUBJECT:** Approval to submit a grant application to California Emergency Management Agency (CalEMA) for renewal funding of the Residential Substance Abuse Treatment (RSAT) grant in the amount of \$179,087 from October 1, 2010 - September 30, 2011.

**REQUEST(S):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the grant application to California Emergency Management Agency (CalEMA) for the Residential Substance Abuse Treatment program in the amount of \$179,087 for the period of October 1, 2010 – September 30, 2011.
2. Approve the Chairman's signature on the Grant Award Face agreement and Certification of Assurance of Compliance.

**SUMMARY:**

The Sheriff's Department has operated the RSAT program since 1999. The current program is offered at the Men's Correctional Facility in Unit C. There are 64 male participants involved this program. The program focuses on drug addiction, life skills, and re-entry for inmates meeting the established criteria for participation.

CalEMA's RFA (request for funding) is limited to only those applicants who were awarded a grant last year. Tulare County Sheriff's Department is listed to receive \$179,087 with a required \$59,696 cash match, on non-competitive funding levels.

**SUBJECT:** Approval to submit a grant application to California Emergency Management Agency (CalEMA) for renewal funding of the Residential Substance Abuse Treatment (RSAT) grant in the amount of \$179,087 from October 1, 2010 - September 30, 2011.

**FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

The funding award from CalEMA is for \$179,087 (75%) with a required \$59,696 (25%) match to be paid out of the Inmate Welfare Fund. There is a 25% cash match which is included in the total dollar amount. Total project costs \$238,783. There are no additional costs and no direct impact to the General Fund. The budget for the RSAT program is already included in the Sheriff's budget for 2010-2011.

**LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

The RSAT grant clearly is in alignment with the Safety and Security initiative of the Strategic Business Plan. More specifically it addresses the outcome to "Provide facilities and resources for training and rehabilitation of criminal offenders".


**ALTERNATIVES:**

The Board could choose not to approve the non-competitive grant application. However, there is no net county cost.
