Approval of Memorandum of Understanding with Sequoia and Kings Canyon National Parks for Cooperative Law Enforcement Assistance

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Sequoia and Kings Canyon National Parks, National Park Service, United State Department of Interior for cooperative law enforcement assistance, effective when the MOU is executed by the last party and remaining in effect until terminated by either party.
- 2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign four copies of the Memorandum of Understanding.

SUMMARY:

This MOU allows Tulare County and Sequoia and Kings Canyon National Park to provide mutual assistance in the performance of law enforcement duties. Both parties agree that the cooperative assistance agreement will result in a reduction of response time, cost to the public and will promote the general welfare, public safety and enjoyment of the area by establishing a consistent and uniform application of law enforcement.

The Department would like to note that this MOU deviates from the County Contract

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protocol as it is an continuous agreement that may be terminated by either party upon sixty days written notice.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

Nothing in the MOU obligates either party to any expenditure of funds. There are no costs associated with this agreement.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Safety and Security Initiative to effectively and fairly investigate arrest, prosecute and punish individuals who engage in criminal behaviors. The MOU will support the Initiative by increasing the protection of the public on Sequoia and Kings Canyon National Parks land.
