Capital Projects - Natural Gas Distribution System Replacement

Project Tulare County Correctional Center

### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to initiate the bid process for the natural gas distribution system replacement project at the Tulare County Correctional Center; and
- 2. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to execute any and all agreements necessary to complete the project.

#### **SUMMARY:**

The Tulare County Correctional Center buildings were constructed in the late 1930's and early 1940's. The County has maintained the natural gas lines and made needed repairs over the years. A project to replace the system was included in the FY 2009/10 Capital Projects budget and is included in the FY2010/11 Recommended Budget. Capital Projects has been working with the Sheriff's Department to work out the logistics of scheduling and completing the project. In light of the recent events in San Bruno, the priority of the project has accelerated the project. Additionally, the timing works well for the Sheriff's Department as space is available to relocate the inmates currently housed at the Men's Correctional Facility.

The natural gas was turned off to the facility on September 14, 2010. Approximately 240 inmates were moved from the site to the nearby Pre-Trial Facility. The Sheriff's Work Alternative Program and Day Reporting Center functions are also relocating to the Pre-Trial Facility.

**SUBJECT**: Capital Projects - Natural Gas Distribution System Replacement Project

**DATE:** September 21, 2010

The County Administrative Office and the Sheriff's Department are working to relocate approximately 70 Sheriff's detective and administrative personnel.

The project will provide for a new natural gas distribution system. The project is expected to take approximately six months to complete.

Under the Public Contract Code section 22000, Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (UPCCAA), the Purchasing Agent may let contracts of \$125,000 or less by in informal procedures. It is requested that you authorize the Purchasing Agent to initiate the bid process for the natural gas distribution system replacement project at the Tulare County Correctional Center and execute any and all agreements necessary to complete the project.

#### FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The project is funded in the Capital Projects Fund 030-086-3200-5183.

#### LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

Replacement of the natural gas distribution system at the Tulare County Correctional Center is linked to the Safety and Security initiative of the Tulare County Strategic Business Plan. Supporting the establishment of long-term business locations fulfills the objective of providing facilities and resources for training and rehabiliation of criminal offenders.

#### **ALTERNATIVES:**

Staff does not have any alternative recommendations.

#### **INVOLVEMENT OF OTHER DEPARTMENTS OR AGENCIES:**

Sheriff's Department will be the end-user of this project. The Purchasing Agent has reviewed and will execute any and all agreements necessary to complete the project.
