#### SUBJECT:

Memorandum of Understanding between County of Tulare and Superior Court of California, County of Tulare to provide County access to Court's Sustain case management system.

#### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- Ratify and approve a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") between County of Tulare ("County") and Superior Court of California, County of Tulare ("Court") to provide County with access to Court's Sustain case management system for the period of December 15, 2010 through September 7, 2012 for \$1358 per license totaling \$211,848. This MOU is retroactive due to delays in finalizing the MOU language.
- 2. Authorize the Chairman to sign three copies of the MOU.
- 3. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed agreement as of December 15, 2010 and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date.

#### **SUMMARY:**

Various departments within the County currently utilize Sustain, the Court's case management system, in order to complete tasks within their respective departments. The Court requested a MOU for the licenses to formalize the terms of the license use, the necessary date for notification of required number of licenses, and to simply the billing and coordination process. Information Technology will coordinate the annual license requests and billing for the County with the Court.

**DATE:** January 11, 2011

The MOU deviates from County contract protocol in that it requires a mutual indemnification. County Counsel has approved the MOU as to form.
