Side Letter of Understanding with the Tulare County Deputy

Sheriff's Association

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Ratify and approve a Side Letter of Understanding between the County of Tulare and the Tulare County Deputy Sheriff's Association (TCDSA), Units 13 & 15, retroactive to November 3, 2010.
- Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed agreement as of November 3, 2010 and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date.

SUMMARY:

The Human Resources & Development Department (HR&D) completed updates and revisions to the County's Personnel Rules in 2008. As TCDSA was in a multi-year Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) at that time (July 1, 2006 – June 30, 2010) they were excluded from the meet and confer process for applicability of the revised Personnel Rules.

During negotiations for a successor MOU the updates and revisions to the Personnel Rules were proposed to TCDSA by HR&D, the following agreement was reached:

1) Updates and revisions to the Personnel Rules, and

2) In lieu of Personnel Rule 6.7.7, Review of Sick Leave Usage, which states in part, "An employee's use of sick leave shall be periodically reviewed by his supervisor. This review will be part of the performance appraisal process for all employees and may be conducted more often as deemed necessary by the employee's supervisor"; the following language shall be added to the MOU in a side letter of understanding (attached):

"Management reserves the right to evaluate absenteeism as a component of an employee's performance and take corrective or disciplinary action as appropriate."
