SUBJECT:

Approve Commitment and Expenditure of a 2011 Caltrans Transportation Enhancement grant application

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Directors:

- 1. Approve commitment and expenditure of Tulare County Redevelopment Agency funds in the amount of \$28,625 from the Pixley Project Area to be used as local match for the 2011 Caltrans Transportation Enhancement (TE) Application.
- 2. Find that leveraging financial resources for the Pixley TE grant is: (a) consistent with the adopted Redevelopment Plan for Pixley (b) implements the affected redevelopment plans by providing a safer and more aesthetically pleasing downtown business district; (c) is consistent with the current Implementation Plan adopted in 2010, pursuant to Health and Safety Code §33131 (a) and (c) and §33133; and (d) will directly benefit low or moderate-income persons.
- 3. Find that there is no other reasonable and available means of financing the local match for proposed activities, and that the County does not have available funding for this purpose.

SUMMARY:

The purpose of the TE Program is to fund projects that will enhance transportation corridors visually and provide increased awareness for both pedestrians and motorists in the business district.

SUBJECT: Approve Commitment and Expenditure of a 2011 Caltrans

Transportation Enhancement grant application

DATE: January 11, 2011

The grant would provide funds to construct curb, gutter, and sidewalk, visually enhance four intersections, and provide street trees, street furniture in the community of Pixley.

The deadline for submittal to the Tulare County Association of Governments (TCAG) is January 14, 2011.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The grant is for \$250,000 in federal funds administered by Caltrans. The local match will be \$28,625. The local match will be provided with tax increment from the Pixley Project Area (RP3-RP3-2000). There is no net County cost to the General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

This links to the goals of the Business Plan's Strategic Initiative:

Quality of Life – The curb, gutter, sidewalk and intersection improvement project will provide a safer and visually pleasing pedestrian corridor within the business district and will also provide additional benefits, including stormwater and transportation infrastructure to the citizens of Pixley.

Safety and Security – The curb, gutter, sidewalk and intersection enhancement improvements will provide a safer transportation network in the business district for the protection of the public.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Board may also choose to submit an application for a lesser amount or may decline to submit for 2011 TE funds.

INVOLVEMENT OF OTHER DEPARTMENTS OR AGENCIES:

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), Caltrans District No. 6 and TCAG to review the application for meeting the guidelines of the TE program; County Counsel to review all documents.
