Approve Fixed-Asset Purchase of a Digital Body Wire Surveillance

Device

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Approve fixed-asset purchase of a digital body wire surveillance device not to exceed \$21,500.

SUMMARY:

The Sheriff's Department is requesting authorization to purchase a state-of-the-art digital body wire surveillance device to replace antiquated equipment. The body wire device will have the capability to produce high-quality audio and video recordings related to drug trafficking and marijuana investigations in Tulare County.

Funding for the device is available from the recently awarded Marijuana Suppression Program grant that was approved by your Board on October 19, 2010—Resolution No. 2010-0858. The purpose of the program is to enhance investigation, arrest, and successful prosecution of marijuana cultivators and traffickers in Tulare and Fresno Counties. The project team consists of the Tulare County Sheriff's Department, the Fresno County Sheriff's Office, the Tulare County District Attorney's Office, and the Fresno County District Attorney's Office.

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FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The cost of the digital body wire surveillance device will not exceed \$21,500. The funding will come from the Cal EMA Marijuana Suppression Program. The grant funds for the purchase of the body wire are included in the Sheriff's FY 2010/2011 operating budget. There will be no net County cost.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Safety and Security Initiative to effectively and fairly investigate arrest, prosecute and punish individuals who engage in criminal behaviors. The digital body wire surveillance device will help fulfill this initiative through the investigation and prosecution of marijuana cultivators and traffickers.
