Affirming the Annual Springville Sierra Rodeo Parade

#### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Affirm the Annual Springville Sierra Rodeo Parade to be held during the month of April of each year in the community of Springville; and
- 2. Affirm the Springville Sierra Rodeo Parade to be an on-going event for future years until such time as conditions of the parade and/or the parade route change.

#### **SUMMARY**:

The Resource Management Agency, Traffic Division, receives an event permit application each year for the Springville Sierra Rodeo Parade. The application is from the Springville VFW Post #9499. The event takes place on Ward Avenue in Springville in the month of April of each year; with a banner across State Route 190 at Tule River Drive and "No Parking" signs placed along State Route 190 from Post Mile 31.0 to Post Mile 32.0 (refer to Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B"). The parade does not utilize State Route 190; only a banner and the "No Parking" signs will be placed on the state highway.

The parade route will proceed along Ward Avenue from State Route 190 to Springville Union School grounds.

The sponsor will be directed to ensure that: (a) participants obey the rules of the

road and; (b) that local residents and businesses are delayed no longer than necessary.

In order for Caltrans to issue a permit for the event, Caltrans requests that the County recognize this event by a resolution. Each year the event is held along the same route. Should the Annual Springville Sierra Rodeo Parade change the route in the future, a new resolution will be required identifying the new route the event is to utilize.

#### FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The County Resource Management Agency should incur no cost, as all necessary signing and traffic control are to be handled by the sponsoring organization. There is no net County cost to the General Fund.

#### **LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

This links to the goals of Business Plans Strategic Initiative #3 - Quality of Life. This event provides for greater recreational and cultural opportunities.

#### **ALTERNATIVES:**

The Board may choose not to declare its support for the proposed event, which could result in its cancellation.

#### INVOLVEMENT OF OTHER DEPARTMENTS OR AGENCIES:

Caltrans will be issuing a permit for the event, authorizing temporary traffic control along State Route 190.


