Agreement to provide up to \$183,439.71 from the California Department of Food and Agriculture for citrus maturity and freeze damage inspections

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- Approve an agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA), providing state subvention of \$183,439.71 to offset costs of regulating maturity and freeze damage of all oranges, lemons, and mandarins being produced and/or processed in the county.
- 2. Authorize the Board Chairman to sign an agreement for July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012.

SUMMARY:

This agreement is intended to render financial aid to the County to provide inspection services for the purpose of regulating maturity and freeze damage of all oranges, lemons, and mandarins being produced and/or processed in the county for FY 2011/2012. The effective date of the agreement is July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012. The deviations from the County contract protocol included in this agreement are as follows:

1) Exhibit C (General Terms and Conditions) (Form 11-0064-SA):

a. Indemnification: Contractor indemnifies State only.

- b. Settlement of Disputes: If there is a dispute, the decision of the Agency Secretary or Designee shall be final.
- c. Potential Subcontractors: County will be responsible to the State for acts/omissions of County's subcontractors.
- d. Right to Terminate: State may terminate without cause with 30 days written notice to the County. The County may not unilaterally terminate the contract without cause. Either party may terminate the contract for cause immediately.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The County will receive up to \$183,439.71 for fiscal year 2011/2012 if this agreement is approved. Revenues and the associated expenditures for this program will be included in the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer's Proposed Budget for fiscal year 2011/2012. There is no net county cost in performing this inspection program.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the <u>Economic Well-Being Initiative</u> to promote economic development opportunities, effective growth management and a quality standard of living. This request to authorize an agreement with the CDFA for the purpose of regulating maturity and freeze damage of all oranges, lemons, and mandarins being produced and/or processed in the county will insure timely continuance of a long-standing program of <u>protecting the County's agriculture-based economy</u> by insuring all immature and/or excessively damaged fruit is kept off the market so that only wholesome fruit will be shipped to consumers.

ALTERNATIVES:

No action or disapproval would mean that the Agricultural Commissioner would not be able to receive financial aid from the CDFA to offset costs incurred in carrying out this program.
