# REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

 Approve sending a letter of support for full funding and reauthorization of the State Criminal Alien Assistance Program to the Senate and House of Representatives Commerce, Justice, Science, and Related Agencies Appropriation subcommittees and the County of Tulare Federal Delegation.

# SUMMARY:

The State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP) provides federal payments to state and local jurisdictions for costs incurred to incarcerate undocumented criminal aliens. The State of California is heavily impacted by the presence of undocumented aliens and the Tulare County Sheriff' Department expenditures to house incarcerated undocumented aliens have been \$3,141,000 over the past two years.

In FY 2010, SCAAP funding was reduced by 17.5% from \$400 million to \$330 million. SCAAP reductions for fiscal year 2011 are currently unknown. The President's recommended fiscal year 2012 budget reduces SCCAP by 59% to \$136 million which will have a devastating impact on local public safety services as they struggle to meet the law enforcement needs of our local communities.

**DATE:** June 7, 2011

The existing authorization for SCAAP expires in at the end of FY 2011 and, therefore, the recommendation is to support reauthorization of the SCAAP program, to reauthorize the program at its current level of \$950 million, and to provide full funding for the program in FY 2012.
