**SUBJECT:** Approval of Agreement with Tulare County Superintendent of Schools.

**REQUEST(S):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve Agreement with Tulare County Superintendent of Schools in an amount not to exceed \$402,461 for the administration of the More Opportunities for Viable Employment (MOVE) Program, from July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012; and
2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign three (3) copies of the Agreement.

**SUMMARY:**

Tulare County Superintendent of Schools administers the More Opportunities for Viable Employment (MOVE) Program in Tulare County.

It is anticipated that families using this program shall be seeking employment opportunities outside of Tulare County and the State of California. When employment, or a reasonable certainty of employment, has been found the MOVE Program assists the family with moving expenses and connecting with a support system; such as family, friends and in some cases former program recipients at the location to which they are moving.

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MOVE Program participants are identified through the TulareWORKs offices and/or partner agencies (e.g., Community Services and Employment Training, Inc., Proteus, Inc.) that assist families in obtaining employment. As of March 2011, for Fiscal Year 2010/2011, the MOVE program has assisted sixty (60) families in relocating to secure gainful employment. Because of the nation wide employment picture, the number of employment opportunities has been reduced. However, the MOVE Program is a viable program that does offer additional employment opportunities to TulareWORKs clients.

During the term of this agreement we expect the MOVE Program to assist seventy (70) families, placing them on the path to self-sufficiency and self-reliance, thus enhancing the families' quality of life through employment.

**FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

The maximum reimbursement for this Agreement is \$402,461 and will be included in the Fiscal Year 2011/2012 proposed budget. No Net County Cost.

**LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Quality of Life Initiative that encourages innovative provision of quality supportive services for at-risk adults, youth and children in state and federally mandated programs. This Agreement increases the ability to fulfill that obligation.

**ALTERNATIVES:**

The Board could choose not to approve this Agreement, but that is not recommended because this may result in the loss of additional employment opportunities for TulareWORKs clients.
