## SUBJECT:

Approval of agreement with Bayfront Youth and Family Services to provide residential program for emotionally а disturbed adolescents.

#### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an agreement with Bayfront Youth and Family Services in an amount not to exceed \$160,000, from July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012, to provide a residential program for emotionally disturbed adolescents in Tulare County: and
- 2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign three (3) copies of the agreement.

#### **SUMMARY:**

Bayfront Youth and Family Services provides an intensively structured residential program for adolescents aged 11 ½ - 17. The program services those emotionally disturbed adolescents identified by Tulare County Department of Mental Health as needing an intensive mental health setting. In addition, the program provides a non-public school for adolescents placed at their facility.

Costs for the program primarily cover the cost of board and care, medical services and necessary pharmaceutical care. While in the program, additional services that are provided include the following treatment types: individual, family, group and

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> multi-family counseling. Assessment, evaluation, and treatment are provided for the clients. The multidisciplinary team includes the child psychiatrist, physician, primary rehabilitation therapists/counselors, registered nurses, teachers. therapist. educational counselors and youth counselors.

> Currently, there is one youth in Tulare County requiring placement in this intensively structured residential program.

#### FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The maximum reimbursement for this agreement is \$160,000 which is included in the Fiscal Year 2011/2012 budget. No Net County Cost.

## LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Quality of Life Initiative that encourages innovative provision of quality supportive services for at-risk adults, youth and children in state and federally mandated programs. This agreement increases the ability to fulfill that obligation.

#### **ALTERNATIVES:**

The Board could choose not to approve this agreement, but that is not recommended because this would result in the loss of services to adolescents in Tulare County that would benefit from the services provided by Bayfront Youth and Family Services.
