Approval of one year extension of benefits consultant agreement

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve a one-year extension with Gallagher Benefit Services, Inc. to provide benefits consulting services related to the selection of various benefits plans offered to County and Special District employees, Retirees, and eligible dependents for the term of July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012.
- 2. Reserve the right to issue an RFP for benefit consulting services either during the term of this contract or in-lieu-of renegotiation of a new contract for FY 2012-2013 if it is determined that it would be in the County's best interest to do so.
- 3. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign three (3) copies of the Agreement.

SUMMARY:

Tulare County relies on the services of a benefits consultant to assist in the solicitation of benefits proposals, selection of vendors, and negotiation of rates for various benefit plans offered to County and Special District employees, Retirees, and their eligible dependents.

On May 23, 2006, the Board of Supervisors authorized retention of Gallagher Benefit Services (GBS), located in Fresno to serve as the County's health benefits consultant. The Board renewed that contract on August 11, 2009 and again on

We recommend your Board approve an extension of the contract with GBS for services to Tulare County for one-year, July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012, while reserving the right to issue an RFP for benefit consulting services either during the term of this contract or in-lieu-of renegotiation of a new contract for FY 2012-13, if it is determined that it would be in the County's best interest to do so.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

Consultant contract fee would remain at \$4,583 per month for the term of the contract. The Human Resources and Development Department's proposed 2011-2012 Budget includes funding for this purpose.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

Strategic Initiative 4: Organizational Performance calls for the County to promote an organization that continuously improves effectiveness and demonstrates the value of its employees in fulfilling the County mission.
