SUBJECT: Approval of agreement with Sunbridge Harbor View Rehabilitation Center to provide short term, inpatient psychiatric services.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Ratify and approve an agreement with Sunbridge Harbor View Rehabilitation Center in an amount not to exceed \$110,000 to provide professional Intensive Day Treatment, Medication Support, Family Therapy, Mental Health, and Targeted Case Management services for Short-Doyle patients and Medi-Cal beneficiaries of the County's Mental Health Program retroactive to July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012. This agreement is retroactive due to inadvertent delays in obtaining signatures. It was impracticable for the Board to take action before July 1, 2011 due to the time needed to prepare, process, and submit the agenda item;
2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed agreement on July 1, 2011 and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date; and
3. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign three (3) copies of the agreement.

SUBJECT: Approval of agreement with Sunbridge Harbor View Rehabilitation Center to provide short term, inpatient psychiatric services.

SUMMARY:

Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA), Department of Mental Health proposes to contract with Sunbridge Harbor View Rehabilitation Center. Sunbridge Harbor View Rehabilitation Center is a Rate Classification Level (RCL) 13/14 Group Home that provides Intensive Day Treatment and Specialty Mental Health Services to Tulare County minors. These minors have been diagnosed as severely emotionally disturbed (SED). In addition, Sunbridge Harbor View Rehabilitation Center's program is geared toward reducing and/or eliminating other restrictive and costly admissions to higher levels of care, i.e. Community Treatment Facilities (CTF's). In addition to the RCL 13/14 Group Home Facility, Sunbridge Harbor View's Program is an innovative residential/rehabilitation skilled nursing facility (SNF) designed to serve 24 adolescents of both sexes in a secured setting. The program is designed to also serve severely emotionally disturbed adolescents in a locked Special Treatment Program, while goal setting for a step-down to the adjacent unlocked residential setting maintained as an RCL-14 group home.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The maximum reimbursement for this agreement is \$110,000 and is included in the Fiscal Year 2011/2012 proposed budget. No Net County Cost.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Quality of Life Initiative that encourages innovative provision of quality supportive services for at-risk adults, youth and children in state and federally mandated programs. This agreement increases the ability to fulfill that obligation.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Board could choose not to approve this agreement, but that is not recommended, because this agreement enables the Tulare County HHSA, Department of Mental Health to fulfill the requirements to provide short term, inpatient psychiatric services mandated by Welfare & Institutions Code 5150.
