Proposition 84 Grant Request for Seville Water Company and

Yettem Water Zone of Benefit

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Authorize the submission of grant applications for funding from Proposition 84, Section 75022, Small Community Infrastructure Improvements for Chemical and Nitrate Contaminants for Seville Water Company and Yettem Water Zone of Benefit in the amount of \$598,000;
- 2. Authorize the Chairman to sign the grant applications; and
- 3. Direct the Clerk to the Board to return the signed grant forms to the Resource Management Agency for submission to the California Department of Public Health.

SUMMARY:

The county of Tulare has been invited to apply for grant funding from the Proposition 84, Section 75022, Small Community Infrastructure Improvements for Chemical and Nitrate Contaminates, for the Seville Water Company and Yettem Water System. The Seville Water Company project is for Nitrate Exceedance – New Well Project. The Yettem Water System project is for Nitrate Exceedance – Remediation Project. It is anticipated that these two (2) projects will be combined into a single project to replace the Seville Water Company distribution system, provide a new source of water for the Seville water system, and deal with nitrate issues with the Yettem water system.

SUBJECT: Proposition 84 Grant Request for Seville Water Company and Yettem

Water Zone of Benefit

DATE: October 18, 2011

On May 24, 2011, the Board of Supervisors authorized the submission of a Notice of Intent (N0I) to apply for Proposition 84 Section 75022 feasibility study funding (Resolution No. 2011-0354). That was the first step in response to the invitation to apply for grant funding for these water systems. In response to our NOI, the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) has extended an invitation to apply for grant funding. This application is due October 31, 2011. Failure to submit the grant application forms to CDPH by the deadline will forfeit the County's ability to apply for this funding.

The County will be applying for funding under the feasibility study component of the grant program. The grant, should it be awarded to the County, will fund the preparation of the plans, specifications and estimate (PS&E) for a replacement distribution system for the community of Seville; complete a study to determine the best method to provide a new water source to the community of Seville (could either be an interconnection with the community of Yettem water system owned and operated by Tulare County or a new well for the community of Seville); prepare the PS&E for the new well or combination of new well and interconnect; and prepare a remediation project for nitrate issues with the Yettem water system.

The staff recommends that the Board of Supervisors pursue this grant opportunity for the Seville and Yettem water systems. As an alternative, the Board of Supervisors could elect not to pursue this grant opportunity. However, in doing so, the Board would delay being able to deal with the water system issues in these two disadvantaged communities.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is not net cost to the County General Fund relative to signing and submitting the grant application. The grant, should it be awarded, will be a 100% grant to prepare the PS&E for the Seville Water Company and Yettem Zone of Benefit.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The approval and submission of the grant applications will assist the Seville Water Company and the Yettem Water Zone of Benefit to meet the goal of providing adequate facilities for the protection of the public pursuant to the Safety and Security strategic initiation. Such an action would also support the Economic Well-Being and Quality of Life strategic initiatives.
