Approve an Amendment to Agreement No. 23796 with U.S.

Department of Justice

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- Approve an Amendment to Agreement 23796 with U.S. Department of Justice for the Annual Federal Equitable Sharing Agreement, retroactive to July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2012. The Amendment is retroactive due to Department of Justice requesting additional information for the certification document.
- Find that the Board had the authority to enter into the proposed Amendment as of July 1, 2011, and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the Amendment to Agreement on that date.
- 3. Authorize the Chairman to sign four copies of the Amendment.

SUMMARY:

On August 16, 2011, your Board authorized the Sheriff's Department to enter into an agreement with the United States Department of Justice (DOJ) for the distribution, maintenance, and use of seized and forfeited drug assets. The signed agreement was submitted to the DOJ. However, the DOJ is requesting additional information for the certification document.

This agreement allows the Sheriff's Department to participate in the Federal Equitable Sharing Program to receive forfeited proceeds from narcotic investigations. The proceeds are used to purchase law-enforcement items such as

safety equipment, firearms, weapons, and electronic surveillance equipment.

The original agreement was approved as to form by County Counsel on August 18, 2009. The department would like to note that this agreement contains federal boilerplate language which deviates from the County's standard contract terms, but is identical to the prior agreement. The only change from the original contract, as amended to date, is changing the signature dates.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The agreement allows for the sharing of cash and other assets forfeited to the participating agencies, thereby relieving general fund costs. There will be no net County cost to the General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Safety and Security Initiative to effectively and fairly investigate arrest, prosecute and punish individuals who engage in criminal behaviors. The Federal Equitable Sharing Agreement will support the Initiative by depriving criminals of the profits and proceeds of their illegal activities and to weaken criminal enterprise by removing the instrumentalities of crime.
